Substation works

St Albans Road, St Albans

Ongoing to late 2022

As part of the Sunbury Line Upgrade, we are delivering power upgrades that will enable bigger, more modern trains to run on the Sunbury Line. We wish to advise of ongoing and upcoming works to build a new electrical substation on St Albans Road, St Albans.

What we are doing

Landscaping activities

Ongoing to late June 2022

- Installing pathways and native plants around the new substation building
- Installing fencing, gates and a new driveway along St Albans Road
- Installing building amenities, cables and electrical equipment inside the new substation building

Out of hours site demobilisation works

Mid to late July 2022

- Removing temporary fencing, site amenities and water barriers from along St Albans Road
- Removing the temporary pedestrian crossing and speed restrictions on St Albans Road
- Re-opening the shared user path on the western side of St Albans Road.

Travel changes

To ensure out of hours works can take place safely, buses will replace trains on sections of the Sunbury Line at different times in **June and July 2022**.

Out of hours substation commissioning and demolition works

August to late 2022

- Connecting cables and turning on electrical equipment within the new substation, which will increase power supply to the Sunbury Line
- Switching off the existing substation on St Albans Road that is being replaced with a newer model
- Using excavators and other machinery to safely demolish the older model substation
- Removing redundant cables and overhead powerlines in the rail corridor
- Non-destructive digging to expose underground services
- More details about these works will be provided closer to the date.

- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am to 5pm, Saturdays and Sundays



What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium to high levels of noise, dust and vibration
- Site demobilisation, substation commissioning and demolition works will be undertaken out of hours. Construction activities that generate lower levels of noise will be undertaken during these times
- Intermittently closing the northbound lane of St Albans Road overnight to assist with water barrier removal works. A contraflow arrangement will be in place during this time
- There will be an increase in construction vehicles accessing St Albans Road. Traffic controllers will be present at times to assist with vehicle, pedestrian and cyclist movements through the area
- Native plants and grasses will be planted between the substation building and St Albans Road. All plants and grasses have been chosen to reflect the natural environment in the area
- Concrete mixers will be on site at times to allow concrete pouring for the new footpath and gutter
- For the safety of rail users and our workers, some activities can only be carried out when trains are not running.
