

Works Notification

24-hour works at the South Kensington Metro Tunnel entrance Childers Street, Kensington

24 January to 26 January 2023

We wish to advise that the overnight track works notified in early January have been rescheduled to 24-hour works at the South Kensington Metro Tunnel entrance.

What we are doing

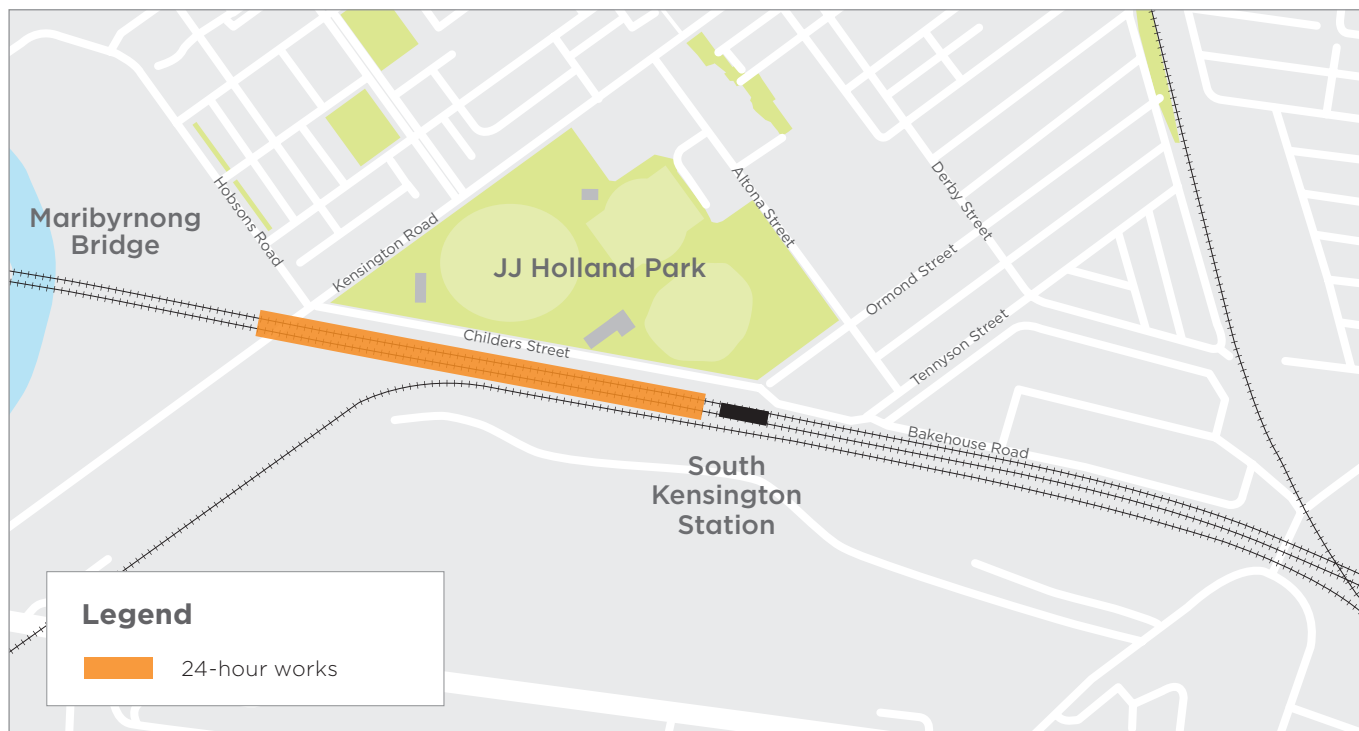
- Relocating rail, installing new track, laying ballast and tamping within the South Kensington Metro Tunnel entrance
- Removing concrete barriers from within the tunnel entrance
- Cleaning ballast within the tunnel entrance
- Works will involve the use of rail excavators, trucks, rollers, tampers and other construction machinery.

When

- 24-hours from 9pm, Tuesday 24 January to 5am, Thursday 26 January 2023.


What you should be aware of


- There will be additional traffic through the area as construction machinery access the rail corridor via Childers Street
- Traffic management will be in place to assist with construction vehicle access, as well as local traffic, pedestrian and cyclist movements around the site
- There is no impact to train services during these works. For the safety of our workers and rail users, some of the activities will take place overnight while trains are not running
- Works are expected to generate medium levels of noise and vibration, with intermittent periods of high-level noise
- Generator-powered lighting towers are required while we complete night works. Where possible, lights will be positioned to face away from residential properties.
