

Tunnels community engagement





- Frederick Street residents Respite measures, weekly door knocks, notifications to Frederick, Kent and Grey streets
- Somerville Road emails to businesses to update on works schedule.
- Youell Street face-to-face with businesses regarding worker parking mitigation measures.
- Email and calls to businesses along Millers Road and Francis Street for TBM1 super load.
- Discussion with Somerville Road business regarding wall to replace existing fence between sites.

Cross passages/Frederick Street





- Two verification drills down to about 30 meters with mobile drilling rig.
- Seismic testing to confirm collected data.
- Grouting and reinforcing area around cross passage with concrete fill from the top.
- Final verification drill to confirm success of the operation.




- The pedestrian crossing at Paringa Rd/M4 Ramp runs concurrently with through/left traffic at Millers Rd.
- Minimum 8 seconds green and 11 seconds flashing red signal provided for pedestrians. But the green signal can extend for over 40 seconds.
- There is a flashing 'Give Way to Pedestrians' sign provided alerting the left turning traffic at Millers Rd when the pedestrian crossing is active at Paringa Rd/M4 Ramp.
- Chevron marking along with raised retroreflective pavement markers (RRPMs) provides delineation.

Next Steps

- MTIA will seek JV to confirm design compliance, and further effect on traffic of introducing pedestrian head start.
- MTIA awaiting response from Department of Transport and Planning on guidelines or limitations for introducing pedestrian head start, pedestrian detection (to extend walk time), and coloured surface treatment.
