Temporary changes to on-street parking access for Osborne Street resurfacing works

Monday 9 to 13 Friday October

As part of works to reinstate the surrounding infrastructure and roads in South Yarra, we will be re-asphalting the eastern lane road surface on Osborne Street. There will be temporary changes to driveway access and parking during this time.

What we are doing

- Works will consist of removing existing asphalt and re-asphalting the eastern lane of Osborne Street between 141 and 101 Osborne Street
- These works will require the use of an asphalt profiler, asphalt paver, excavator, compaction equipment and delivery trucks.

Construction on surrounding infrastructure and roads

Major construction of key structures for the Metro Tunnel's tunnel entrance in South Yarra is nearing completion, with construction works underway to complete the surrounding infrastructure and roads, including along Arthur, Osborne and William streets.

This includes reinstatement of the Osborne Street traffic island in October, which will require the closure of Osborne Street at the traffic island and changes to traffic conditions during it's reinstatement. Information about this and other works will be provided closer to the date.

What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise and some vibration with some high-level noise during the removal and relaying of asphalt
- On-street parking along Osborne Street will be temporarily unavailable during this time and will be blocked off from Monday 9 October, to ensure the safety of local traffic and crews
- During this time, the location for rubbish bin collections may be impacted. We will move rubbish bins from properties between 141 and 101 Osborne Street on Tuesday night for collection.
- Please ensure that your bins are on the street and ready for collection by 5pm on Tuesday 10 October. Once rubbish has been collected, a crew member will return your bin to the front of your property
- Traffic management will be in place along Osborne Street to help facilitate pedestrian and vehicle access to properties. Vehicle and footpath access to and from residential properties will be maintained at all times, with minor delays
- Local vehicles will be detoured via Toorak Road, Davis Avenue and Fawkner Street.

When


- Parking will be removed from the morning of Monday 9 October
