

# Heatherton works update

## **April**

Works are underway in Heatherton to deliver Suburban Rail Loop (SRL) East for Melbourne and Victoria.

#### What we are doing

- Day works 7am 6pm Monday to Friday and 7am 1pm Saturday
- Night works 6pm 7am Monday to Saturday
- **Extended works** 6pm until 10pm Monday to Friday






We will minimise impacts to the community by:

- Transporting materials from site in covered trucks to minimise dust
- Removing hazardous materials in accordance with Environment Protection Authority regulations
- Scheduling works to reduce impacts
- Installing road safety and detour signage
- Maintaining access to homes and businesses
- Monitoring noise, dust and vibration levels
- Turning off equipment when not in use
- Using noise blankets on equipment
- Minimising light spill.




#### Major milestone update
