Overnight works in St Kilda Road median

St Kilda Road

Monday 22 and Tuesday 23 April 2024

Works to complete the central median of St Kilda Road next to the chiller plant and ventilation shafts will take place out of hours when trams aren't running.



When we'll be working

Works will take place overnight when trams aren't running, **8pm to 6am**:

8pm Monday 22 April to 6am Wednesday 24 April 2024

The timing of work may change depending on weather.

What we'll be doing

- Adjusting the fencing along the tram corridor
- Replacing tactiles at Anzac Station tram stop south western pedestrian crossing
- Excavation and lowering in of three new drainage pits adjacent to the tram tracks.

What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate periods of mediumlevels of noise associated with the use of an excavator and use of a saw cutter
- To safely complete these works, the majority of works will take place after the last tram passes through at 1am
- Lighting will be in place, with hybrid fuel and electric light towers in use to reduce noise wherever possible
- There will be no changes to access to properties during these works
- St Kilda Road will remain open during these works.

Where

These works will take place along the central median of St Kilda Road next to the chiller plant and ventilation shafts, between Bowen Lane and just south of Bowen Crescent.
