Footpath reconfiguration

Swanston Street

From Wednesday 3 July 2024

Construction of the Metro Tunnel Project's new State Library Station is continuing with above ground entrance works and fit-out of the underground station at the corner of Swanston and La Trobe streets. To carry out these works safely, a long-term reconfiguration of the footpath adjacent to the site on Swanston Street is required.



When we'll be working

 The footpath reconfiguration will be in place from Wednesday 3 July 2024.

What we'll be doing

- Removing and installing site hoarding and barriers, and installing a gate to facilitate site access for deliveries
- Fitting out the seven-storey deep underground station which involves deliveries and installation of materials including steel beams and glass, lighting, elevators, escalators and ticket gates
- Surface works including installation of a tram pole, underground services, bollards, kerb and pavement outside the main entrance to the new station
- These works involve saw cutting, excavation, use of road and demolition saws, vacuum trucks, mobile cranes, concrete trucks, rigid trucks, forklifts and hand tools.

What to be aware of

- There will be traffic impacts for motorists, cyclists and pedestrians during these works. Everyone is advised to take extra care when travelling through the area
- The Swanston Street western footpath adjacent to the work site will close and pedestrians will be diverted onto the existing northbound traffic lane (see map)
- Barriers will be installed to separate pedestrians from traffic during this on-road diversion
- Access for cyclists travelling northbound on Swanston Street will be maintained via a shared use lane with motorists
- Local motorist access to short term parking and loading zone spaces on Swanston Street, north of Little La Trobe Street, will be maintained. A right hook turn is in place, allowing motorists to exit Swanston Street by turning right onto La Trobe Street (see map)

- The Swanston Street crossing on the north side of La Trobe Street will remain closed.
 Pedestrians are advised to use the Swanston Street crossing on the southern side of La Trobe Street (see map)
- Access to businesses, RMIT and residential buildings will be maintained at all times
- Some of the works taking place in this location will generate high levels of noise.

 Swanston Street between La Trobe and Little La Trobe streets.




