Overnight Works

St Kilda Road

July 2024

In July finishing works will be undertaken in areas around the Anzac Station precinct. This includes asphalting sections of road and will require overnight closures of St Kilda Road southbound and northbound lanes.

When we'll be working

To minimise disruption to traffic on St Kilda Road, works will take place overnight, **8pm to 6am**

- Southbound lane works: 8pm Tuesday 1 July to 6am Friday 5 July 2024
- Northbound lanes: 8pm Monday 8 July to 6am Friday 12 July 2024

The timing of work may change depending on weather.

What we'll be doing

- Closing the southbound lanes of St Kilda Road (away from city) between Dorcas Street and Bromby Street to:
 - Asphalt the future left turn lane from St Kilda Road into Domain Road
 - Installing final sections of kerb adjacent to the station entrance
 - Install detector loops at the traffic lights at the intersection of St Kilda Road and Domain Road
 - Install signage.

- Closing the northbound lanes of St Kilda Road (towards city) between the Toorak Road Tram Stop pedestrian crossing and Albert Road overnight, to:
 - Install detector loops at the traffic lights at the intersection of St Kilda Road and Bowen Lane and St Kilda Road and Albert Road
 - Asphalt the separated bike lane adjacent to the Albert Road Reserve station entrance.
- Completing final rectification works in the precinct, including:
 - Install final pedestrian tactiles at the St Kilda Road pedestrian crossing at Bowen Lane
 - Install final pedestrian tactiles at the St Kilda Road crossing at Toorak Road
 - Removing temporary fencing adjacent to the tram tracks between Bowen Lane and Bowen Crescent
 - Reinstate of traffic barriers adjacent to tram tracks on Park Street
 - Traffic barrier removal and line marking through the area.

What to be aware of

 Detours will be in place during the closure of St Kilda Road, with access around the works via Kings Way. (See map)

- During works on northbound lanes, access and egress for Albert Road properties, including the driveway of 18 Albert Road (Domain Hill) will be via Kings Way
- During works on the northbound lanes, access for the St Kilda Road driveway of 400 St Kilda Road (Botanica) will be via Bowen Lane (See map)
- Traffic controllers will be in place to assist with this traffic movement
- Installation of detector loops are expected to generate a short period of high level noise
- Asphalting works are expected to generate periods of medium levels of noise.

Where

- Works will be carried out at the intersection of Domain Road and St Kilda Road
- Works along the St Kilda Road southbound lanes will be between Dorcas Street and Bromby Street
- Works along the St Kilda Road northbound lanes will be between Toorak Road and Albert Road
- Due to the nature of these works, progress may be impacted by weather conditions.
