Western Portal security measures



- Plant species and park furniture have been selected to maintain line of sight
- Security fence along embankment which is 355m across three sections, flood wall and security cameras in the tunnels
- Providing adequate lighting for the following:
 - Childers Street
 - Pocket park
 - PSO building
 - Bike parking
 - CYP egress building
 - Footpaths



Construction update





System integration testing update



- System integration testing and trial operations is ongoing
- In late July, RNA successfully deployed the last major planned software upgrade for the Metro Tunnel Project, completing the Communications Based Train Control (CBTC) signalling commissioning
- Provided upgrades to the High Capacity Signalling (HCS) system in the Eastern and Western Corridors and in the tunnel
- This is a critical and significant milestone six years in the making, brings significant improvements and upgrades in readiness for Day 1 operations.



Operational Noise and Vibration monitoring



- Train testing is occurring regularly within the Metro Tunnel
- On-site monitoring of operational noise and vibration is also taking place during train testing
- Monitoring has been undertaken at key locations across the entire Metro Tunnel alignment
- The purpose of the monitoring is to validate the modelling for the project and to ensure that the tunnel complies with the Environmental Performance Requirements (EPRs)
- To date, the monitoring is showing compliance across the alignment.





Hobsons Road update



- Demolition of the buildings at 5-39 Hobsons Road will begin from early October 2024, following state heritage approvals
- Further information will be provided to the community prior to commencement of works
- Further engagement for heritage interpretation of the building will commence soon
- Archival photography of the building is planned for early September.

Completion of demolition & site demobilisation	Q2 2025



- Reinstatement of the intersection of Hobsons Road, Childers Street and Kensington Road now being undertaken by City of Melbourne and CYP.

Community update



Parking permits

- Eligible residents in Ormond, Tennyson and Altona streets have been informed that the Metro Tunnel Project will no longer be covering the cost of a resident priority parking permits after 30 September 2024
- MTPO on behalf of City of Melbourne recently surveyed residents on whether resident priority parking restrictions should remain in place on these streets
- Residential parking permits exempt residents from the restrictions, allowing parking longer than the limit shown in the parking sign
- Survey responses have been provided to City of Melbourne
- City of Melbourne advise that the results will assist in the further development of the Kensington Neighbourhood Parking Review undertaken earlier this year.
