Signalling upgrades

Wednesday 4 December to Sunday 8 December 2024

Shepparton Line Upgrade is delivering more frequent and reliable services on modern VLocity trains. To enable signalling upgrades, coaches will replace trains between Seymour and Shepparton during a works blitz from Wednesday 4 December until Sunday 8 December, 2024.



When we'll be working

Works will take place from
**7am Wednesday 4 December
until 10.30pm Sunday
8 December, 2024.**

What we are doing

Coaches will replace trains on the Shepparton Line to allow for important signalling works to be undertaken safely.

Works will include:

- Installing, testing and commissioning axle counters and signal antennas
- Fitout and commissioning of signal rooms
- Removing redundant signalling equipment
- Construction of access tracks for maintenance.

What to be aware of

There will be traffic management with stop/slow signs at 16 level crossings between Seymour and Shepparton.

Works will take place 24 hours a day, so there may be an increase in noise and light spill at night.

Shepparton Line Upgrade

The Shepparton Line Upgrade is delivering more frequent and reliable services on modern VLocity trains.

Stage 1 is complete, delivering 10 extra weekly services along the line, and Stage 2 delivered VLocity trains to Shepparton for the first time in late 2022.

Stage 3, which is underway, will enable nine daily return services on weekdays between Shepparton and Melbourne.

The Shepparton Line Upgrade is creating more than 600 jobs.

The project is part of the Regional Rail Revival program which is upgrading every regional passenger line in Victoria and creating 3,000 jobs.
