

Heatherton and Clarinda works update

March 2025

Works are underway in Heatherton and Clarinda to deliver Suburban Rail Loop (SRL) East for Melbourne and Victoria.

What we are doing

Stabling Facility, Heatherton

- Building the Eastern Tunnel Entrance (ETE) and Western Tunnel Entrance (WTE)
- Building a permanent Network Support Facility (NSF)
- Moving underground and above ground services.

Tunnel Boring Machine (TBM) launch site, Clarinda

- Building the Clarinda Tunnel Access Structure (TAS) and a temporary power supply facility for the TBMs
- Site investigations.

Day works 7am – 6pm Monday to Friday and 7am – 1pm Saturday

 Night works 6pm – 7am Monday to Saturday ▲ Extended works 6pm – 10pm Monday to Friday, 1pm – 5pm Saturday and Sunday, 24-hour works at times

TBM launch site, Clarinda	Ongoing ♠ A From mid-March to early-May	 Building the temporary power supply facility and TAS, including earthworks, concreting, piling, ground improvement and hoarding installation Safely removing hazardous material 	 Workers in specialised protective clothing as we continue safe removal of hazardous materials Moderate levels of noise, vibration, light and dust Increased truck movements Delivery of construction equipment at night

Impacts


As with all major infrastructure projects, surrounding communities may experience some impacts during construction. The Project supports businesses and residents to continue to live, work, study and shop in their community.
