

CLYDE ROAD UPGRADE

FEBRUARY 2025

We're upgrading Clyde Road in Berwick, relieving bottlenecks, improving traffic flow, and making your journey safer and more reliable.

About the project

As part of the Clyde Road Upgrade, we'll:

 add additional lanes in each direction between Bermersyde Drive and Enterprise Avenue

- widen the existing bridge over the Princes Freeway from 6 lanes to 10 to increase capacity
- upgrade the intersection at Kangan Drive and Clyde Road by adding dedicated bus lanes and additional through and turn lanes to help traffic move more smoothly
- upgrade the Princes Freeway ramps and intersections to make it safer for vehicles to enter and exit the freeway
- build new and upgrade existing shared walking and cycling paths



 install new street lighting, road signage, drainage, and landscaping.

Enhancing connectivity for pedestrians and cyclists travelling north or south on Clyde Road




Building on the recent upgrades to Thompsons, O'Shea and Narre Warren-Cranbourne roads
