

Rail corridor works

Drouin to Traralgon

June - August 2025

We are commissioning new signalling infrastructure and finalising works between Drouin and Traralgon as part of the Gippsland Line Upgrade, which will enable more frequent and reliable services.



When we'll be working

Works will take place **from 7am to 7pm** with some **24-hour** works required throughout this period.

The timing of work may change depending on weather and ground conditions.

Thank you for your patience while this important work is underway.

What we'll be doing

We will be undertaking 24-hour works from **10pm Thursday 19 June until Monday 4 August 2025**. Works will include:

- signalling works, cable hauling and installation of trackside equipment along the rail corridor
- construction of maintenance access roads between Drouin and Traralgon
- track works at Morwell including rail milling, installation and modification of new turnouts

- testing and commissioning of the new signalling infrastructure between Drouin and Traralgon
- upgrades to signalling infrastructure and boom gates at the Bank St level crossing Traralgon, and the Access Rd level crossing Morwell.

What to be aware of

- you will see us carrying out low-impact and non-disruptive works during the day and night
- an increase in heavy machinery, vehicles and workers within the area
- temporary changes to traffic, with speed reductions required to ensure the safety of workers and the community.

How we are minimising impacts

Dust

We use a range of measures to minimise dust from construction activities, including placing dust monitors in and around the construction site, staging works to minimise exposed areas and the use of water carts to wet down work areas.

Noise and vibration

To minimise potential noise and vibration impacts we monitor noise and vibration levels to make sure they are within the Environment Protection Authority noise control guidelines and limit out of hours work.

Lighting

Where possible, portable light towers will be positioned away from residential properties to prevent light spill into homes and solar light towers will be utilised to limit noise.

Plan your journey

Coaches will replace Gippsland Line trains for all or part of the journey from **Saturday 14 June to Wednesday 13 August**.
