Road closure

Swanston Street

From Tuesday 30 September to late October 2025

We are reasphalting Swanston Street from late-September 2025.



When we'll be working

- During the night from 8pm to 5am, Monday to Thursdays
- There will be no vehicle access to Swanston Street during night works. Vehicle access will be maintained outside of these days and hours.

The timing of work may change depending on weather.

What we'll be doing

- Setting up the site
- Removing the existing road surface
- Installing bike separator kerbs
- Laying asphalt to form the new road surface
- Line marking the new road.

What to be aware of

- Major road works are required to reasphalt Swanston Street
- Swanston Street will be closed overnight between La Trobe and A'Beckett streets from 8pm to 5am, Monday to Thursdays to safely complete these works
- These works include profiling, asphalting, kerb works and line marking which may produce medium to high levels of noise and some vibrations
- No vehicles will be able to access
 Swanston Street from La Trobe and
 Little La Trobe streets including for deliveries and waste collection
- Access to buildings in Little La
 Trobe Street will be maintained via
 Elizabeth Street, with a temporary
 two-way traffic arrangement under
 the direction of traffic control

- Swanston Street between La Trobe and A'Beckett streets will remain open to vehicles during the day
- During these works, the northern crossing at Swanston Street and La Trobe Street will be closed. Pedestrian access will be maintained from the southern crossing (see map)
- During these works, pedestrians can only cross Swanston Street at the dedicated pedestrian crossings at Franklin and La Trobe streets
- There will be no on street parking available on Swanston Street between La Trobe and A'Beckett streets during these works
- Cyclists travelling northbound on Swanston Street will be required to dismount and use the footpath during these works
- Pedestrian access to businesses and residential buildings will maintained at all times.


