Works Notification October 2025

We're working on both sides of Bulleen Road as tunnelling continues on North East Link.

What we'll be doing

Activities to support tunnelling works will take place 24 hours a day, seven days a week. During this time, we'll aim to minimise noise and light impacts away from your property as much as possible.

Oversize deliveries

We'll be delivering large pre-cast panel beams that will form part of the southern ventilation structure and roof of the tunnel.

Deliveries will occur between 11pm and 5am Mondays to Fridays, with up to six deliveries each night.

Most deliveries will arrive from the Eastern Freeway and Bulleen Road before entering our work site off Bulleen Road near the Marcellin College and Manningham Hotel & Club access road.

Managing construction impacts

Throughout our works, you may experience noise, light, dust, and vibration. We manage these impacts through real time monitoring, water carts and street sweepers, targeted lighting, and reducing noise and vibration within the construction zone.

You may notice workers on local streets capturing photos as part of our ongoing management of these impacts. We do this in conjunction with our modelling to ensure we have an accurate understanding of how these impacts may be felt in different areas. We will notify you before capturing any photos that include your property and we are happy to provide these photos upon request.

You may also see workers machinery in place, in and around construction areas, workers completing surveys in local streets and an increase of trucks removing dirt from our worksites.

To stay safe, please follow all instructions from signage and traffic controllers. We appreciate your patience and understanding throughout these works.

October closures

In September, works progressed well on Manningham Road and Bulleen Road to safely carry out drainage works as part of the future Manningham Road interchange.

We previously advised that from Tuesday 30 September to Monday 6 October, a southbound Bulleen Road closure between Manningham Road and Noelle Street, and lane closures on Bridge Street and Manningham Road, would be in place.

Due to progress of works, these works in October are no longer required.

We thank you for your patience while we've completed these critical works.

Eastern Freeway upgrades

Works are progressing across all our sites, with bridges and major new interchanges continuing to take shape along the freeway.

We recently installed the new Heyington and Estelle bridges across the freeway, and we'll continue finishing works on the bridges and surrounding path networks, ready for opening later this year.

Works are also progressing on the new city side of the Doncaster Road bridge, and we've begun installing our first noise wall panels along Koonung Creek Reserve.

While we work, there will be lane, ramp and full freeway closures in one or both directions, at times on the Eastern Freeway. Please plan ahead and allow additional time.

We're working hard to minimise disruptions to the local community. Please plan ahead and allow additional travel time.
