Major construction of Town Hall Station is complete. Final works are continuing, including final station fit out, station testing and commissioning and reinstatement of community spaces.


Works snapshot: October 2025

Major construction of Town Hall Station is complete, with final works continuing. Construction works within the Town Hall Station precinct during October 2025 include:

- Station entrance construction and underground build-out works at the City Square, Flinders Quarter and Federation Square sites
- Ongoing fit-out of above ground structures and civil surface works at City Square

- Flinders Lane reinstatement
- Gantry modification and hoarding installation at the Flinders Quarter site
- Awning reinstatement preparatory works at 244 Flinders Street
- Train testing through the tunnel and along the Cranbourne, Pakenham and Sunbury lines.

Normal construction hours

7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday 7am to 1pm, Saturdays

Upcoming works in your area

City Square site



7am to 2:30am, Monday to Friday 7am to 2:30pm, Saturday

Works occurring this month include:

- Reinstatement works including the construction of garden beds, footpaths, street furniture, paving, and delivery of materials via Flinders Lane
- Ventilation equipment will operate during all works below ground, and site lighting will be required for evening and overnight works
- These works are expected to generate medium to high levels of noise.

Flinders Quarter site



7am to 2:30am, Monday to Friday 7am to 2:30pm, Saturday

Works occurring this month include:

- Construction of the station entrance, installation of services and station fit out is ongoing
- This involves use of the tower crane, mobile surface cranes, concrete pumps, and regular delivery of materials via Flinders Street and Royston Place
- Ventilation equipment will operate during all works below ground, and site lighting will be required for evening and overnight works
- The Flinders Street eastbound lane will remain closed until early 2026 to facilitate deliveries into the Flinders Quarter site.

Flinders Lane east reinstatement works



7am to 2:30am, Monday to Friday 7am to 2:30pm, Saturday

- Works to reinstate the Flinders Lane drainage, services, kerbing and pavements are ongoing, and involve the removal of existing infrastructure, installation of services, and then reinstating the kerbs, footpath and road
- Flinders Lane will close between Russell Street and Swanston Street for reinstatement works between the following times:
 - 24 hours from Wednesday 1 to Friday 3 October
 - 24 hours for three days in mid-October
- Local traffic access will be maintained via Russell and Elizabeth streets, and a detour for westbound traffic will be in place via Collins Street and managed by traffic control
- A section of the Swanston Street eastern footpath between Flinders Lane and Flinders Street and the Flinders Lane southern footpath will close until mid-October
- A pedestrian detour will be in place via the Flinders Lane northern and Swanston Street western footpaths
- The Flinders Lane northern footpath will then close from mid-October until late October
- A pedestrian detour will be in place via the Flinders Lane southern footpath and managed by traffic control
- These works are expected to generate medium periods of noise with intermittent periods of highlevel noise.

Flinders Lane awning reinstatement preparatory works



7am to 2:30am, Mondays to Fridays

- Preparatory works to reinstate the awning at 244
 Flinders Street will continue in October, including installation of the structural steel that forms the base of the awning
- During the steel installation, the Flinders Street footpath will be closed for five shifts in late October
- Access to all local buildings and businesses will be maintained
- Access to the Flinders Street tram stop #5 will be maintained from the southern end of the western pedestrian crossing
- Separate notification will be provided for these works.

Federation Square site




Town Hall Station will include an entrance at Federation Square. Construction is ongoing for this entrance.

24-hours, Monday to Sunday

Works occurring this month include:

- Below ground structural works and fit-out of the station passenger areas and operational rooms, including installation of waterproofing materials, steel and concrete
- Above ground service installations, reinstatement works and structural works, involving the removal of existing pavement, installation of new drainage and conduits, construction of a new concrete slab and installation of the station entrance canopy and associated scaffolding
- During the scaffold install, a section to the west and the south of the site will be closed to pedestrians, including the pedestrian crossing to St Paul's Cathedral
- This closure will be in place for up to three days in mid-October
- These works will generate some periods of high-level noise as well as regular deliveries via the Flinders Street loading bay and crane
- Flinders Street westbound remains closed with all vehicles to turn left at St Kilda Road.
