- Graham Ross (GR) quired the sheet piling works. TV noted they will look to implement measures to minimise noise impacts from piling works, sheet piling works will be carried out for up to one month.
- GR queried spoil disposal. TV confirmed spoil will be sent to appropriate designated facilities based on material type.
- GS quired concrete segments. TV advised they are manufactured off-site in Victoria.
- GS queried use of recently signalised traffic lights on Burwood Highway installed by Laing O'Rourke. TV confirmed they are in frequent use.
- Matthew Duke (MD) requested notification of any impacts to Burwood Highway.
