Overview & Document Control

Pursuant to Clause 4.9.2(a) and 4.9.2(c) of the Incorporated Document, Attachment 2 contains landscape design plans, including sections, elevations, and plant species associated with the Eastern Freeway Upgrades - Hoddle Street to Burke Road.

Attachment 2 also contains tree retention and removal plans which have been developed in response to tree retentions and removals required to be undertaken within the Project Area. These plans align with the requirements of Arboricultural EPR AR1 (Develop and implement a Tree Removal Plan) and EPR AR2 (Implement a Tree Protection Plan(s) to protect trees to be retained). Tree retention and removal plans also support and demonstrate the design’s compliance with key elements of the Urban Design Strategy including Key Principle 1: Identity, and Objective 1.4: Existing landscape character, which seek to protect existing landscape and vegetation.

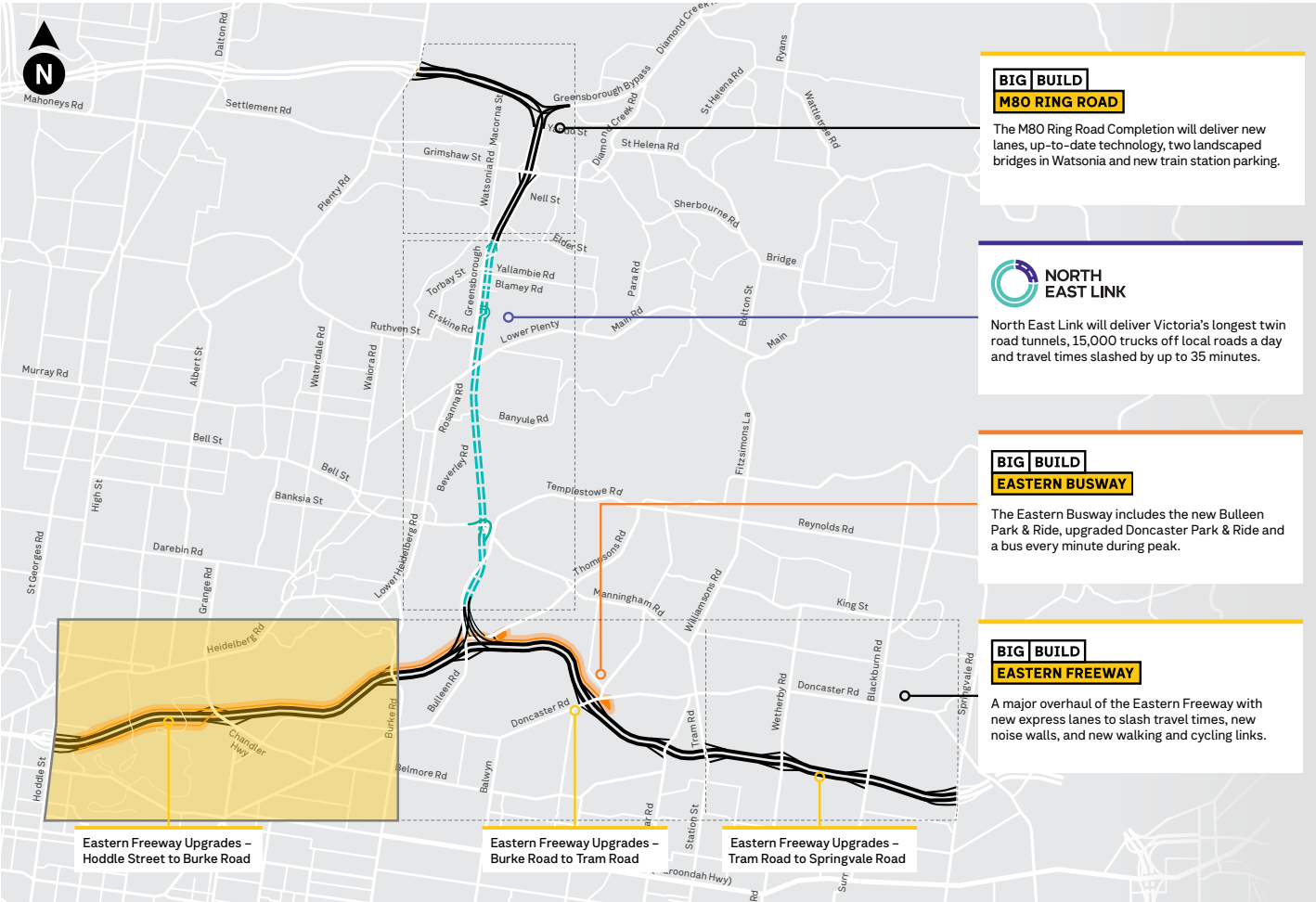
