

Upcoming day and night works for North East Link

Service relocation works on Greensborough Road in Macleod and Watsonia

Works are continuing on Greensborough Road to move utility services, such as gas and power, to provide space for North East Link. This is ahead of major construction starting in late 2021.

We will be working day and night in several locations on Greensborough Road to complete the relocation of these services until late August 2021.

Since these works began in October 2020, over 1.7 kilometres of gas pipe and 1.5 kilometres of power lines have been installed.

What we'll be doing

Service relocation works

We are currently moving a high-pressure gas main and power lines beneath Greensborough Road. This activity is supported by a site compound near Lenola Street, Macleod which contains worker amenities along with materials and equipment storage.

This will involve:

- Accessing the site compound near Lenola Street, Macleod during working hours
- Using high-pressure water and vacuum to verify underground services
- Saw-cutting into the roadway and excavating trenches up to three metres deep
- Laying new pipes and conduits before backfilling the trench
- · Reinstating the road surface with asphalt.

Traffic management

We use traffic management during works on Greensborough Road to safely guide vehicles, cyclists, and pedestrians through the area. These temporary measures are put in place to protect workers and the community. This will involve:

- Lane closures and reduced speeds on Greensborough Road until late August 2021
- Side road closures near work areas on Greensborough Road until late August 2021
- Overnight northbound lane closures on Watsonia Road near Greensborough Road, with detours in place via Grimshaw Street, from late June to mid-July 2021.

Where and when we'll be working

We will be working in several locations on Greensborough Road in Macleod and Watsonia until late August 2021.

Night works

These will be happening on Greensborough Road:

- Extending into Strathallan Road and Cooley Avenue from June to July 2021
- Between Richards Avenue and Watsonia Road from late June to late July 2021
- Between Erskine Road and Powley Parade until late August 2021.

Working hours are **7pm** to **6am**, Monday to Sunday, with traffic management set up from **6.30pm**.

Day works

These will be happening between 293 and 333 Greensborough Road, from Powley Parade to Richards Avenue, from mid-June to late July 2021.

Working hours are **7am** to **6pm**, Monday to Saturday, with traffic management set up from **6.30am**.

Please note dates and times are subject to change.

What this means for you

We will contact properties near work areas in advance to explain planned disruptions in more detail and how we can provide support. If you have any questions or concerns about these works, our community engagement team is available day and night.

During these works you may notice:

- · Work crews and construction vehicles in the area
- Noise from machinery and equipment, including cutting saws, excavators, large trucks, and generators
- Light from portable sources and construction vehicles
- Changed traffic conditions on the road and restricted driveway access near work areas
- No planned gas or power outages; however, your service provider will notify you directly if this changes.

Managing construction impacts

We carefully manage our works in line with the project's strict Environmental Performance Requirements to ensure we are working safely in the community. Safety is our priority and we ask for your assistance by following all instructions and signage.

Mitigation measures include:

- · Temporary fencing to secure work areas
- Noise suppression equipment, such as sound blankets
 where possible
- Dust suppression techniques, such as spraying work areas with water
- Designated access routes to site for construction vehicles.
