

Upcoming day works for North East Link

Electrical service relocation works on Greensborough Road and Edward Street in Macleod

Works are continuing on Greensborough Road to move utility services to provide space for North East Link. This is ahead of major construction starting in late 2021.

In mid-July, we will be working during the daytime in several locations on Greensborough Road and Edward Street for the final stage of electrical service relocation works.

What we'll be doing

Electrical service relocation works

We will be completing tie-in and commissioning works for newly relocated electrical services.

This will involve:

- Occupying sections of Greensborough Road and Edward
 Street with designated work areas
- Using elevating work platforms to access power poles and hauling overhead cables
- Cutting into the roadway and excavating trenches to access underground cables.

Traffic management

We use traffic management when working near roadways to safely guide vehicles, cyclists, and pedestrians around work areas.

This will involve:

- Lane closures and reduced speeds on Greensborough Road
- Road closure on Edward Street up to 80 metres from Greensborough Road intersection with local detour in place on Tuesday 13 July and Thursday 15 July
- Greensborough Road reduced to one traffic lane in each direction between Torbay Street and Cooley Avenue on Saturday 17 July
- Side road closures on Yallambie Road and Cooley Avenue with local detours in place on Saturday 17 July.

Where and when we'll be working

Works on Greensborough Road, between Erskine Road and Torbay Street, will take place from **Monday 12 July** to **Saturday 17 July 2021**.

Works on Edward Street will take place on **Tuesday 13 July** and **Thursday 15 July 2021**.

Working hours are **8.45am** to **3.30pm** from Monday to Friday, and **5am** to **6pm** on Saturday.

Please note dates and times are subject to change.

What this means for you

We will contact properties near work areas in advance to provide further information about planned disruptions.

During works you may notice:

- · Work crews and construction vehicles
- Noise from machinery and equipment
- Traffic management equipment, signage, and personnel
- Restricted driveway access near work areas.

Please note your service provider will contact you in advance of any planned power outages that may be required.

We appreciate your patience and understanding throughout these works.
