



# Works notification

## Park Street Westbound Lane Closure Park Street

**9am - 4pm, Monday 7 March 2022**

Service proving works are required to identify services in the roadway on Park Street. These works will inform major utility connection works later in 2022.

### What we are doing

#### Monday 7 March

- Setting up traffic control on the corner of St Kilda Road and Park Street
- Closing the left hand turn from St Kilda Road into Park Street
- Opening service pit lids in the road and inspecting services.

### What to be aware of

- On Monday 7 March there will be no left turn from St Kilda Road northbound into Park Street
- A traffic detour will be in place via Dorcas Street and Wells Street
- Access to the Hallmark Apartments driveway will be maintained via a right turn from Park Street
- Works will be carried out during standard working hours
- Works involve opening a pit lid and visually inspecting services, as such they are not expected to generate noise
- Tram services will not be affected

- If works cannot proceed on Monday 7 March, they will be completed on Tuesday 8 March
- Please be aware the traffic set up required for these service proving works will be required for a longer term period of 3-4 weeks later in 2022 when the work to complete the utility connection works will be undertaken. Notification of these works and the timeframe will be provided closer to the date.

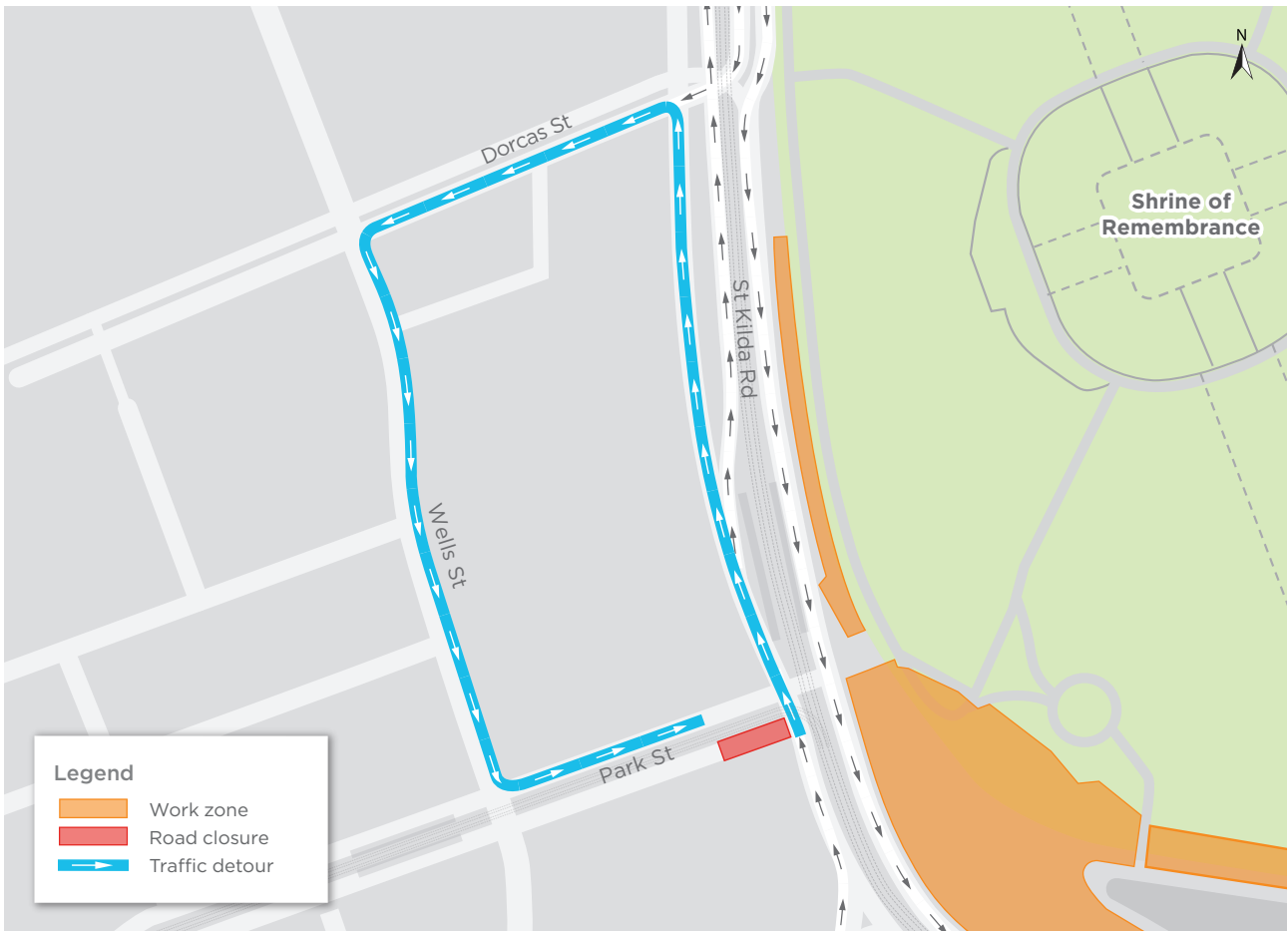
