Site Investigations

Laverton to Werribee

Monday 12 September to Friday 30 September

Site investigations are taking place to help inform planning and design for Stage One of Geelong Fast Rail.

What we are doing

Visual surveys using a drone flying over the rail corridor between Laverton and Werribee.

These survey works will include:

- Two qualified staff launching drones from several locations close to the rail line near Laverton, Aircraft, Williams Landing, Hoppers Crossing and Werribee Stations
- Drones flying over the rail corridor.

What to be aware of

- A small area will be cordoned off around each drone launch site to ensure the safety of pedestrians.
- The drone survey will only collect imagery to be used to inform the planning and development of Geelong Fast Rail.
- There will be no impact on local roads, and minor impacts on some public access areas adjacent to the rail corridor.

- Signage will be in place to assist with access and wayfinding where required.
- Access to properties and businesses will be maintained throughout these works.

Geelong Fast Rail

Geelong Fast Rail will deliver faster services between Geelong and Melbourne's CBD with a travel time of around 50 minutes enabled through a major investment to the Werribee corridor.

The Werribee corridor has been selected as the route to deliver faster services for Geelong, as it is the shortest and most direct rail path between Geelong and Melbourne.

Construction is expected to commence in 2023, subject to relevant Victorian and Federal planning, environmental and other government approvals.

Hours of work:

Works will be undertaken from 9.30 am to 4 pm, Monday to Friday, and take up to 15 business days.


The timing of these works is subject to weather and ground conditions.
