

Works notice

Bowen Crescent closures

From Tuesday 21 November to Saturday 15 December 2023

Bowen Crescent will be closed at the intersection with St Kilda Road to build a raised pedestrian crossing and install underground services.

What we are doing

- Closing Bowen Crescent at the intersection of St Kilda Road from 21 to 25 November 2023
- Reopening the left turn lane from Bowen Crescent onto St Kilda Road from 27 November
- These works will require the use of excavators with hammer attachments to break back the road surface, saw cutters, Non-Destructive Digging trucks, compaction equipment, delivery trucks, forklifts and asphalt pavers
- Installing new kerbs and constructing a raised pedestrian crossing
- Upgrading underground services.

What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate high levels of noise during the breaking back of the existing road surface and some vibration when compacting the new raised pedestrian crossing
- There will be a detour in place from St Kilda Road to Bowen Crescent via Albert Road and Kings Way
- There will be a detour in place from Bowen Crescent to St Kilda Road via Kings Way
- There will be a pedestrian detour in place to cross Bowen Crescent near Queens Lane
- Some parking on Bowen Crescent will be occupied to allow for these works to take place safely
- Access to driveways will be maintained unless otherwise notified
- From 27 November to 15 December 2023, access from Bowen Crescent to St Kilda Road will reopen but the left turn from St Kilda Road to Bowen Crescent will stay closed.

When

 The full closure will be in place 24 hours a day from From Tuesday 21 November to Saturday 25 November Works will take place during standard construction hours Monday to Saturday.

Utility installation on southbound lanes along St Kilda Road from 21 until 24 November 8pm to 5am each night

To complete utility works along St Kilda Road we're closing southbound lanes of St Kilda Road between Dorcas Street and Toorak Road overnight, 8pm to 5am each night, from 8pm Tuesday 21 November until 5am Friday 24 November.

Resurfacing of St Kilda Road and the St Kilda Road and Toorak Road intersection, 26 November to Friday 1 December

As part of the finishing works for the Metro Tunnel Project we're resurfacing the northbound lanes along the St Kilda Road and Toorak Road intersection and sections of the southbound lane along St Kilda Road, overnight, 6pm to 6am, from 6pm Sunday 26 November to 6am Friday 1 December 2023.




