Community Consultation Summary

We're upgrading Clyde Road to improve safety and ease congestion, adding an additional lane in each direction between Enterprise Avenue and the freeway interchange, and upgrading the intersections of Kangan Drive and the Princes Freeway.

Consultation

Earlier this year, we sought to better understand how people currently use Clyde Road, and asked for feedback on what we should consider in our planning.

To do this, the community were invited to provide their thoughts, comments and concerns between 20 March and 5 April 2023.

What you told us

Your feedback has provided important local insights.

The roads aren't safe due to the increased population and lack of infrastructure.

Key themes

Traffic and transport

81% of respondents are currently concerned about congestion and 75% are concerned about traffic flow.

66% community members rated current traffic conditions as "poor" or "very poor".

When asked to comment what they would improve, 135 people suggested extra lanes on Clyde Road or Princes Freeway bridge.

Safety

29% of drivers responded that adding more lanes would make travelling along Clyde Road feel safer.

People also believe safety should be the number 1 consideration when improving the area for pedestrians and cyclists.

When offering comments many participants expressed concern about the safety of pedestrians on the Princes Freeway bridge.

Road usage

77% of Clyde Road users use the road in peak periods from 7am to 9am and 3pm to 6pm.

83% of people use Clyde Road to access the Princes Freeway.

Connectivity to major freeways is what people value most about the area.

Construction planning and impacts

30% of people believed the replanting of shrubs and fauna should be considered in our planning.

20% believed minimising noise should be considered and

18% responded our planning should consider minimisation of impacts to local fauna.

43% of surveys responded that detours should be considered when identifying construction impacts.

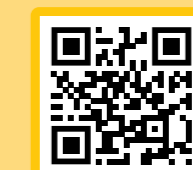
