24-hour rail maintenance works

Kensington

Friday 9 February to Monday 12 February 2024

To prepare the Sunbury Line for future services via the Metro Tunnel, 24-hour rail works will take place between North Melbourne and Sunshine stations.



When we'll be working

We'll be working from 8pm Friday 9 February to 3am Monday 12 February.

What we'll be doing


- Rail maintenance activities, including removing and relocating existing rail and signalling assets and upgrading signalling software along the rail corridor
- Testing and commissioning signalling assets
- These activities will require the use of non-destructive digging machines, excavators, elevated work platforms, cable trucks, tandems, delivery trucks and crews with hand tools.

What to be aware of

- For the safety of passengers and our workers, some activities can only be performed when trains are not running. Bus replacements will operate at certain times during these works (see overleaf for details)
- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise with intermittent periods of high-level noise. Where possible, higher impact works will be scheduled during the day and noise reduction mats will be placed around generators

- Generator-powered lighting towers are required while we complete night works. Where possible, lights will be positioned to face away from residential properties
- There will be an increase in construction vehicles using the rail access point on Childers Street and the Hobsons Road laydown area. Traffic controllers will be present at times to assist with vehicle, pedestrian and cyclist movements around the area
- To support construction activities, there will be reduced parking on Childers Street. Accessible parking will remain available near South Kensington Station
- Access to residential properties and businesses will not be impacted.
