

Works notice



Update on surface works requiring Flinders Lane and alley way closures

Flinders Lane including Manchester Lane and Cocker Alley

From Wednesday 13 to Saturday 23 March 2024

Current works being undertaken in Flinders Lane, Cocker Alley and Scott Alley are nearing completion, as we prepare them for future pedestrian access into the new Town Hall Station.



When we'll be working

- Ongoing until **Saturday 23 March 2024** (excluding Labour Day long weekend)
- Monday to Friday, 6:30am to 2:30am**
- Saturday, 7am to 1:30pm**

The timing of work may change depending on weather.

What we'll be doing

- From 5pm Friday 8 March, works will be complete in Scott Alley and the laneway will re-open to the public
- From Wednesday 13 until Saturday 23 March, we will complete kerb and bluestone paving works on Flinders Lane and Cocker Alley and will be repaving the entrance to Manchester Lane off Flinders Lane.

What to be aware of

- These works will generate some periods of medium to high level noise including the use of a non-destructive digging truck, saw cutting, concrete pours and paving
- Access to residential buildings and businesses will be maintained
- Emergency egress from the Nicholas Building onto Cocker Alley will be maintained.

Pedestrian arrangements

From Wednesday 13 until Saturday 23 March:

- Scott Alley will be open to pedestrians
- Cocker Alley will remain closed
- The Flinders Lane southern footpath will be open but narrowed between Cocker Alley and Royston Place
- The Flinders Lane northern footpath will be open during the day until 8pm
- From 8pm to 2:30am, both the southern and northern footpaths on Flinders Lane will be closed to pedestrians between Swanston Street and Royston Place, with access to businesses and apartments maintained
- The entrance to Manchester Lane, via Flinders Lane, will be closed to pedestrians from 8pm to 2:30am during week nights. Entry will be maintained via Collins Street. Access will be maintained to the Ginger Olive restaurant from Flinders Lane and Manchester Lane (via Collins Street).

Traffic arrangements

From Wednesday 13 until Saturday 23 March:

- Flinders Lane will be closed to vehicles between Swanston Street and Royston Place. Drivers travelling from Russell Street down Flinders Lane will be able to access driveways and delivery areas under traffic management

- Driveway access will be maintained to properties between Russell Street and Regent Place, and vehicles exiting car parks on Flinders Lane will need to travel east to Russell Street under traffic management and a detour using Flinders Street or Collins Street
- For access to properties on Flinders Lane between Swanston and Elizabeth streets, drivers will need to enter Flinders Lane via Elizabeth Street
- Cyclists should observe detour routes and will be able to access properties or delivery areas under traffic management
- Vehicle access onto Manchester Lane will be via Collins Street from 8pm to 2:30am weeknights.
