Kerb extension works

Swanston and La Trobe streets

From Tuesday 21 May 2024

We wish to advise that works to widen the pedestrian kerb are required on the north-east corner of La Trobe and Swanston streets.



When we'll be working

- 24-hours, Monday to Saturday, for four weeks, or until the works are complete
- Swanston Street bicycle lane closure: 9pm to 6am Monday to Saturday, until works are complete.

The timing of work may change depending on weather conditions.

What we'll be doing

- Widening the kerb on the northeast corner of La Trobe and Swanston streets
- These works involve saw cutting, excavation, removal of existing street furniture, pole relocation, concrete pours, installing kerbs and pavement works
- These works involve the use of road and demolition saws, vacuum truck, concrete trucks, rigid trucks, forklifts and hand tools.

What to be aware of

- During the works, motorists travelling southbound on Swanston Street will be unable to turn left onto La Trobe Street. A temporary hook turn will be in place, allowing motorists to exit Swanston Street by turning right onto La Trobe Street (see map)
- During night works, between 9pm and 6am, cyclists travelling southbound on Swanston Street will be required to dismount and use the Swanston Street footpath instead (see map)
- The width of the southbound bicycle lane on Swanston Street will be reduced throughout the works. Cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area

- The Swanston Street pedestrian crossing on the north side of La Trobe Street will not be in use. The Swanston Street pedestrian crossing on the south side of La Trobe Street will continue to operate (see map)
- Access to businesses, RMIT and residential buildings will be maintained at all times
- Additional surface works will be required in this location later in the year
- Some of these works will generate high levels of noise.


