## Paver renewal works and Flinders Street footpath closure

### Flinders Street, Melbourne

11 September to late September 2024

Due to paver renewal works, a section of the northern Flinders Street footpath will temporarily close from 8pm to 6am until late September.



#### When we'll be working

- From 11 September to late September 2024
- These works will take place from 8pm to 6am, Monday to Friday, to minimise pedestrian and business impacts.

The timing of work may change depending on weather.

#### What we'll be doing

- Establishing a site on the northern Flinders Street footpath, directly west of Degraves Street, using temporary fencing and bollards
- Removing existing bluestone pavers along the northern Flinders Street footpath, pouring a new concrete slab, placing crushed rock, and installing new pavers
- Works will involve the use of a small excavator, forklift, bin and small truck.

#### What to be aware of

- The northern Flinders Street footpath will be closed during these works, from Degraves Street towards Elizabeth Street, from 8pm and 6am until late September
- A pedestrian detour will be in place via the southern Flinders Street footpath and existing Flinders Street pedestrian crossings
- Access to local businesses and buildings will be maintained by traffic control during opening hours
- During the day, the footpath will reopen to the public and will be slightly narrowed
- Traffic management and wayfinding will be in place to manage the closure
- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise, with intermittent periods of highlevel noise associated with paver removal.


