

Works notice



Footpath closures

A'Beckett Street

Monday 12 May to November 2025

A long term 24 hour closure of the A'Beckett Street northern and southern footpaths between Swanston and Stewart streets will be in place from Monday 12 May to November to facilitate the final stages of works for this site including the demolition of the last acoustic shed, capping beam and worker shed removal, and the reinstatement of A'Beckett Street.



When we'll be working

- 7am to 2:30am on weekdays
- 7am to 2:30pm on Saturdays
- The footpath closures will be in place **24 hours a day**.

The timing of work may change depending on weather.

What we'll be doing

- Removal of acoustic shed cladding
- Demolition of acoustic shed steel structure
- Use of a mobile crane to facilitate the removal of capping beams and crib sheds
- Saw cutting and hammering works
- Reinstatement of roads and footpaths within site.

What to be aware of

- To safely complete these works both the northern and southern footpaths will be closed 24 hours a day during these works, between Swanston and Stewart streets
- Pedestrian detours will be in place via Elizabeth Street, Franklin Street and Stewart Street, and Little La Trobe Street and Literature Lane (refer to map)
- These detours are subject to change depending on the nature of the work at any given time to ensure we maintain pedestrian safety
- Access to local buildings and businesses will be maintained at all times
- Traffic controls will be in place to manage the closures and assist guiding pedestrians and local access for vehicles
- There may be times when local vehicle access is restricted. Impacted stakeholders will be directly notified
- These works are expected to generate medium to high levels of noise.

Where we'll be working

- A'Beckett Street, between Swanston Street and Stewart Street.

Stages of works

The following stages of works are planned for A'Beckett Street and are subject to weather and other conditions.

Stage one: Shed demolition and capping beam removal works from May to mid-year

Stage two: Removal of worker sheds adjacent to the RMIT basketball courts during June

Stage three: Public realm and reinstatement works including paving and road reinstatement from July to November

We'll continue to keep you notified of the stages of works as they progress.

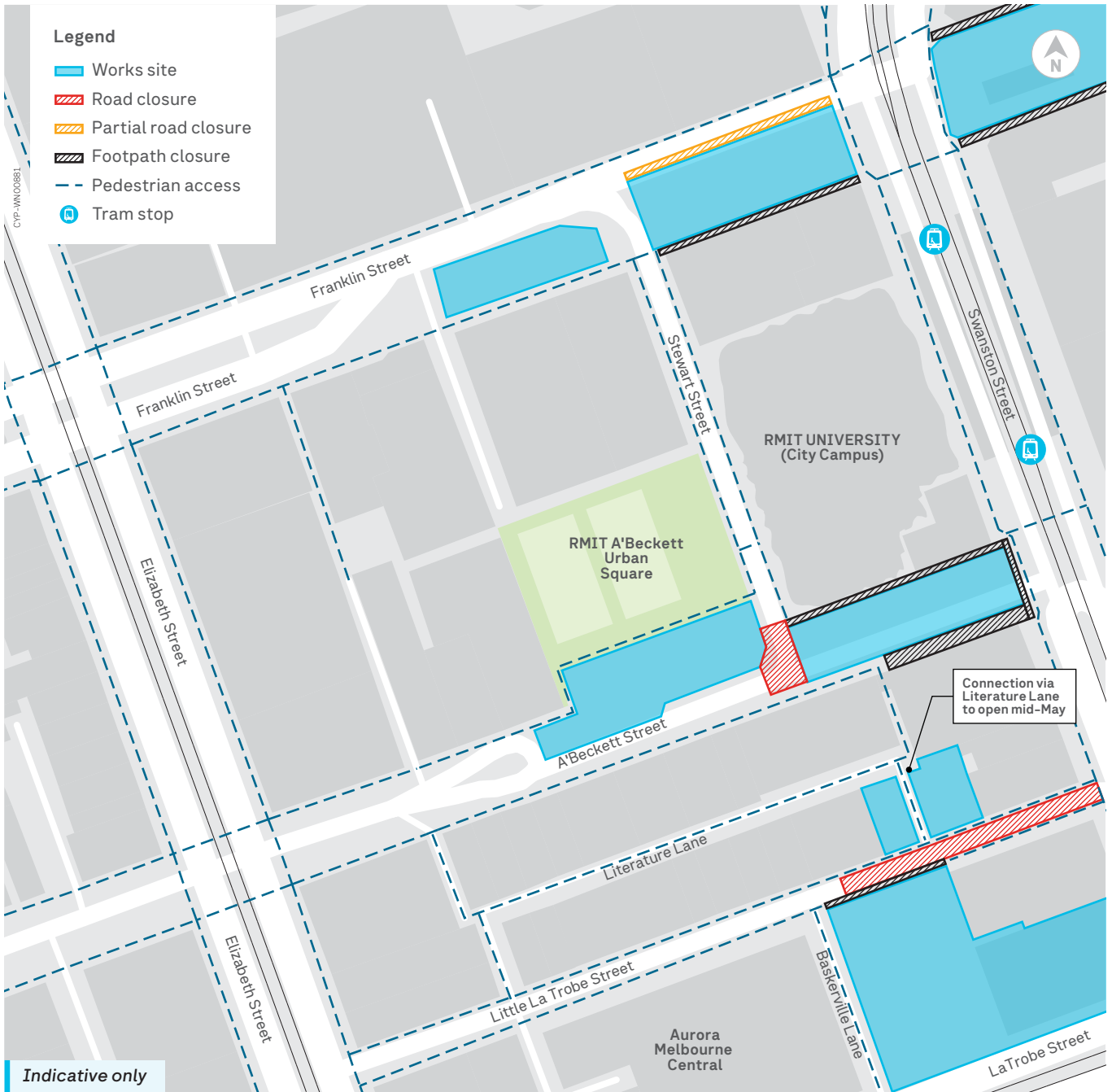
