## Franklin Street remediation works

### Franklin Street

2 to 10 September

We are remediating sections of Franklin Street road surface



#### When we'll be working

- During the night from **6pm to 4am, Tuesday 2 to Friday 5 September** and **Monday 8 to Wednesday 10 September**
- There will be no vehicle access to Franklin Street during night works. Vehicle access will be maintained outside of these dates and during the day.

The timing of work may change due to weather.

#### What we'll be doing

- Setting up the site
- Removing the existing road surface
- Laying asphalt to form the new road surface
- Line marking the new road.

#### What to be aware of

- We are remediating sections of Franklin Street, including repairing potholes and the road surface
- These works include profiling, asphaltting and line marking which may produce low to medium levels of noise and some vibrations
- Franklin Street will be closed overnight between Elizabeth and Stewart streets for two nights from 6pm to 4am on 2 and 3 September.

- No vehicles will be able to access Franklin Street from Elizabeth Street to Stewart Street including for deliveries and waste collection. Access will be available from Swanston Street to the Milano building car park and to Stewart Street during this closure
- Franklin Street will be closed overnight between Elizabeth and Swanston streets for three nights from 6pm to 4am on 4, 8 and 9 September, reopening 4am 10 September. During these times, no vehicles will be able to access Franklin Street between Elizabeth and Swanston Street including for deliveries and waste collection. Access to Stewart Street will be maintained via A'Beckett Street
- Franklin Street between Elizabeth and Swanston streets will remain open to vehicles during the day
- Buildings with vehicle access via Franklin Street are advised to speak to their building manager about alternative car park access during these works
- Access to the Milano and 58 Franklin Street car park will be via Therry Street only during night work closures under the direction of traffic control
- Alternative parking arrangements are available for residents with car park access within the works area. Contact the Metro Tunnel Project Team on [cyp@metrotunnelcyp-dc.com.au](mailto:cyp@metrotunnelcyp-dc.com.au) or 1800 105 105
- During night works, pedestrians can only cross Franklin Street at the dedicated pedestrian crossings at Elizabeth and Swanston streets

- To safely carry out these works, barriers will be set up on the footpath
- A pedestrian diversion will be in place at the eastern crossing at Franklin and Elizabeth Street
- To ensure property access is maintained during these works, there will be no on street parking and limited loading zones available on Franklin Street during the works period. We encourage people to use surrounding streets or building loading bays during this time
- Pedestrian access to businesses and residential buildings will be maintained at all times
- Where possible, waste collections and heavy vehicle deliveries are to be scheduled between 7am and 6pm on these days. Contact your building manager for more information.

#### Where we'll be working

- Franklin Street between Elizabeth and Swanston streets.

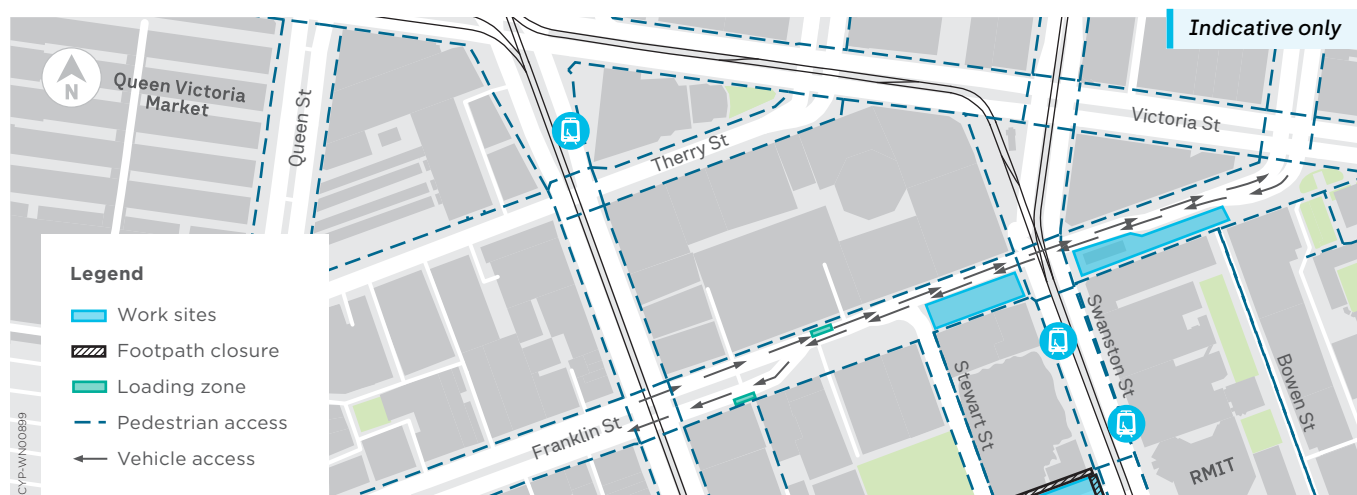
