Shepparton Line Upgrade – Signalling Upgrades

Shepparton Line Upgrade is enabling more frequent and reliable services on modern VLocity trains.

Coaches will replace trains for all or part of the journey on the Shepparton and Seymour lines **from Friday 31 October to Sunday 14 December**. During this time, crews will undertake works to install, test and commission the line's new signalling system.

What we're doing

Signalling works will take place between Shepparton and Seymour, 24 hours a day while coaches replace trains. Works will include:

- Installing, testing and commissioning new signalling equipment along the rail corridor
- Removal of redundant signalling equipment
- Track works between Murchison and Seymour
- Train driver training for the new signalling system.

What to expect

- Localised traffic management at level crossings between Shepparton and Seymour for the safety of works crews and road users. Access will be maintained.
- Works will occur 24 hours a day. Due to the nature of works, impacts on nearby communities will be minimal.

Changes to the way you travel
