




Things to do around Anzac Station

The station is near some of Melbourne’s most iconic destinations, including the Shrine of Remembrance, the Royal Botanic Gardens and Albert Park.

Indicative walking distances:

	Shrine of Remembrance	400m walk Time: 5 minutes
	Royal Botanic Gardens	600m walk Time: 7 minutes
	Albert Park	1km walk Time: 15 minutes

Moving around the station and precinct

Anzac Station is underground. Allow extra time to move between street entrances and station platforms.

The times below are estimates based on average walking speed and consider the furthest distance between entrances or connecting services in the precinct.

Location to/from	Location to/from	Approximate travel time
Street level station entrance	Station platform	2-3 minutes
Street level station entrance	Tram stop	1-2 minutes
Street level station entrance	Bus stop	2-3 minutes

Accessibility

Anzac Station is one of the most accessible stations on the network, with features including step free platform access, lifts, braille and tactile signs, hearing loops and accessible toilets.

Victorian-first platform screen doors will mean safer boarding, better climate control and less noise.

Walking and cycling

Wider footpaths and raised crossings around the station make walking in this area safer.

Around 120 bike parking spaces and more than 4km of protected bike lanes near the station make cycling safer and easier.

Staying safe


-  Platforms are around 225 metres long, make sure you allow enough time to move through the station safely.
-  Do not run in the station to avoid the risk of slips, trips and falls.
-  Escalators are steep. Hold onto the handrail to ensure you don't fall.
-  Platform screen doors open and close automatically. Wait for doors to fully open and allow passengers to get off the train before you get on. Never try to force a door open.
-  When travelling with children, always hold their hand when boarding to avoid being separated.

Bus and tram connections




Anzac Station includes Melbourne’s first direct tram/train interchange with an accessible tram stop linked by escalators, stairs and lifts to the train station platforms.
