Site Conduct Rules

VIDA expects high standards of conduct across all its projects.

VIDA, together with the Suburban Rail Loop Authority and the Department of Transport and Planning, has developed Site Conduct Rules that describe standards of behaviour expected of all people working on, or attending, project sites. The rules address respect and fair treatment, safety and wellbeing, conduct and work practices, and professional integrity.

VIDA requires the Site Conduct Rules to be displayed prominently at each VIDA worksite, including at all site entry points.

Adherence to the Site Conduct Rules is a condition of entry to VIDA sites. A breach of the rules may result in removal from site and exclusion from project activities.

The Site Conduct Rules should also form part of site inductions.

The Site Conduct Rules do not limit or reduce the contractor's responsibility for the management, supervision and control of the site, whether arising under contract, at law or otherwise.
