

## **ARDEN**




- Installation of the falsework entrance's brick arches has begun.
- 15 arches will be installed to form the station entrance each weighing up to 65 tonnes.
- The amended draft Arden Station Precinct Development Plan remains on public display until the end of August.



# **PARKVILLE**




- Works continue on the main station box, and excavation of the station entrances
- Large concrete pours to form the roof slab which has required the closure of the Royal Parade southbound service lane until late August to facilitate crane set up.



## **TOWN HALL**




- At the Flinders Link site, the breakthrough into the existing Campbell arcade was completed
- At the Flinders Quarter site works are ongoing with concrete pours on B2 level. This. Excavation is ongoing at B3 level
- Below Swanston Street in the central cavern, the eastbound rail platform tunnel bench is nearly complete with works ongoing in the westbound rail platform tunnel bench.





- Recently reached a major milestone at Anzac Station with the final concourse level concrete poured
- The 300m long concourse level is now linked between the station's north and south boxes
- The first section of the tram/train interchange station entrance roof slab is also now poured.








### STRUCTURES AND LINING



- TBM support infrastructure has been removed
- Sidewall formwork system started assembly this month (pictured)
- Sidewall and invert (slab) construction is underway in both the eastbound and westbound tunnels
- Franklin and La Trobe St under track excavation is complete. Excavated materials were transferred through TBM tunnels to Arden
- Franklin and La Trobe adit construction which includes installing formwork, reinforcement and concrete has commenced and will continue for the next 18 months
- One of the lining and formwork systems has been transferred to the eastbound tunnel and will be reconfigured for platform tunnel arch lining profile.

### A'BECKETT STREET SITE




- Logistics for structures and lining works continue through A'Beckett Street site shed 24hrs
- Intermittent Sunday shifts are required over the next six months as works ramp up in rail tunnels and Franklin and La Trobe Street adits
- On Sunday 5 September electrical works are required at A'Beckett and Stewart Street intersection from 7am. Traffic changes will apply. Access to buildings will be maintained at all times but please allow an extra 20 minutes.
