

Works notice

Pedestrian gantry removal

Northern Grattan Street footpath, between Royal Parade and Kernot Road

Monday 29 May to early July 2023

The pedestrian gantry on the northern site perimeter will be removed from late May to early July to enable the next stage of reinstatement and public realm works at Parkville Station.

What we are doing

- Replacing the northern Grattan Street east site hoarding with temporary fencing, in front of the University of Melbourne Medical Building
- Disassembling and removing the northern Grattan Street east pedestrian gantry in this location in sections using a 30-tonne crane, franna crane and crawler crane
- The pedestrian gantry will be removed in two stages
- The first stage of gantry removal will occur between Royal Parade and the University of Melbourne Medical Building's Grattan Street entrance
- The second stage of gantry removal will occur between the University of Melbourne Medical Building's Grattan Street entrance and Kernot Road.
- Emergency egress from local buildings and institutions will be maintained at all times
- Signage will be in place to safely direct pedestrians around the work site
- These works are expected to generate periods of medium level noise
- Once complete, reinstatement and public realm works will commence in this area. These works will also require staged footpath closures, with access to local buildings to be maintained. Separate notification will be provided for these works.

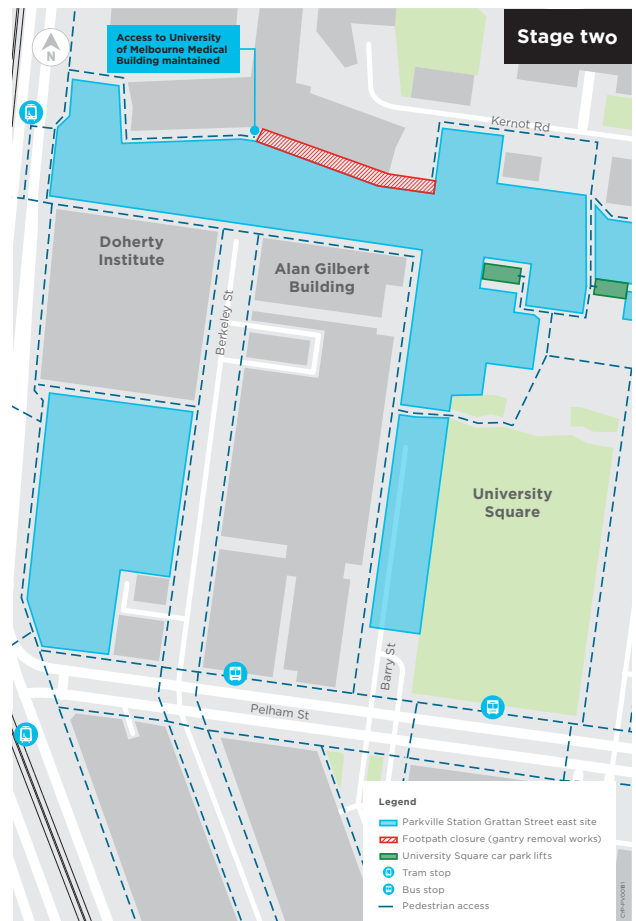
- 7am to 6pm, Mondays to Fridays

What to be aware of


- During each stage of gantry removal, a section of the northern Grattan Street footpath will be closed
- During the first stage, the northern Grattan Street footpath will be closed between Royal Parade and the University of Melbourne Medical Building's Grattan Street entrance for approximately two weeks
- During the second stage, the northern Grattan Street footpath will be closed between the University of Melbourne Medical Building's Grattan Street entrance and Kernot Road for approximately two weeks
- Pedestrian access to all local buildings and institutions will be maintained and the University of Melbourne Medical Building's Grattan Street entrance will remain open
