

# MICKLEHAM ROAD UPGRADE – STAGE 2

MAY 2025

We're upgrading Mickleham Road between Dellamore Boulevard and Craigieburn Road, Yuroke to make your journey safer and more reliable.

As part of the upgrade we'll:

- add extra lanes, increasing Mickleham Road to three lanes in each direction
- add traffic lights at the Mickleham Road and Dunhelen Lane and Cookes Road intersections
- build walking and cycling paths.

#### Status

A business case has been completed, which examined the upgrade in detail to recommend a design and identify the best delivery approach.

Planning work completed to date includes traffic modelling, constructability assessments, economic modelling, stakeholder/ community consultation and environmental investigations.

Completed Construction timelines will be known once our planning has progressed further.
