## MICKLEHAM ROAD UPGRADE – STAGE 2

JULY 2023

We're planning for the potential upgrade of Mickleham Road between Dellamore Boulevard and Craigieburn Road, Yuroke to make your journey safer and more reliable.

As part of our investigations, we're looking at potential solutions to:

- add more lanes
- upgrade key intersections
- build cycling and walking paths.

### Benefits

In our planning for the potential Mickleham Road Upgrade – Stage 2 we're seeking solutions to:

- enhance the benefits that will result from the Mickleham Road Upgrade – Stage 1, between Somerton Road and Dellamore Boulevard (currently in construction)



- enhance the benefits that will result from the Craigieburn Road Upgrade, between Hume Highway and Mickleham Road (currently in construction)
- improve road safety
- reduce conflict points at key intersections along the road
- reduce congestion and improve travel times
- boost road capacity and cater for population growth and increased vehicle movements
- make it easier and safer to walk and cycle in the area.

## Status

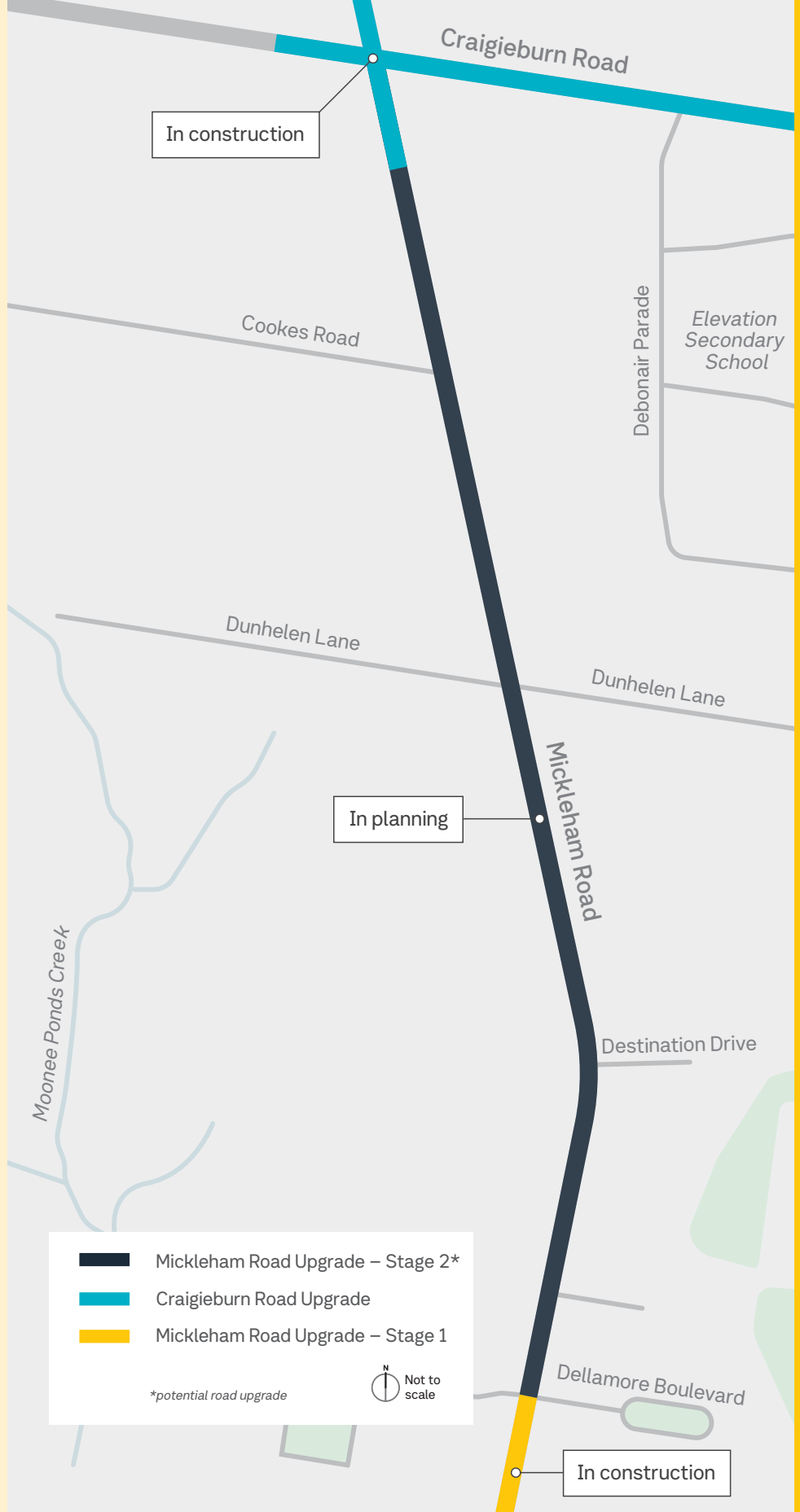
We're currently developing a business case and our planning work is expected to be complete in 2024.

The business case is a comprehensive document that will provide a detailed examination of the potential upgrade to help inform government decision making. It will evaluate the benefit, cost and risk of different options and provide a rationale for a preferred design solution.


To help inform the business case we're undertaking traffic modelling, constructability assessments, economic modelling, community consultation and environmental investigations. This work will allow us to understand environmental and social impacts, develop design options and confirm scope and costs of different options.

## Project timeline

  - The Australian and Victorian governments committed funding to develop a business case
-  **Late 2022**
  - Planning commenced
-  **Early 2023**
  - Community and business consultation
-  **2023**
  - Business case planning and development.
-  **2024**
  - Business case complete
