

Works notice

Rescheduled start date: Drainage works and separated bike lane installations

Tuesday 29 August to Saturday 7 October

Works to upgrade the drainage and install new separated bike lanes on St Kilda Road have been Rescheduled.

What we are doing

- Setting up a temporary construction site to safely complete the works (see map overleaf for location)
- The site will be set up overnight on Tuesday 29 August while there is less traffic along St Kilda Road. This will involve construction vehicles moving and positioning fencing and barriers
- Once the site is set up works will begin to upgrade the drainage and install the bike lanes. This involves non-destructive digging, saw cutting, excavating, installing conduits, constructing bike lanes, and asphaltting
- This construction site will be in place for approximately six weeks.

What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate periods of high levels of noise associated with the use of the road saw and breaking back the road surface
- Cyclists will continue to merge with vehicle traffic, south of Kings Way
- The St Kilda Road vehicle entrance to The Lucient will be unavailable during this time with access via Queens Lane. Pedestrian access to the building will be maintained with no changes to the footpath
- To set up the site safely, St Kilda Road northbound lanes will be closed, between Toorak Road and Dorcas Street, from 8pm Tuesday 29 August to 6am Wednesday 30 August. Traffic will be able to detour via Kings Way and Park Street.

When

- These works will take place during standard construction hours, from 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 7am to 1pm on Saturdays
- There will be one night of works to set up a temporary construction site, from 8pm Tuesday 29 August to 6am Wednesday 30 August.

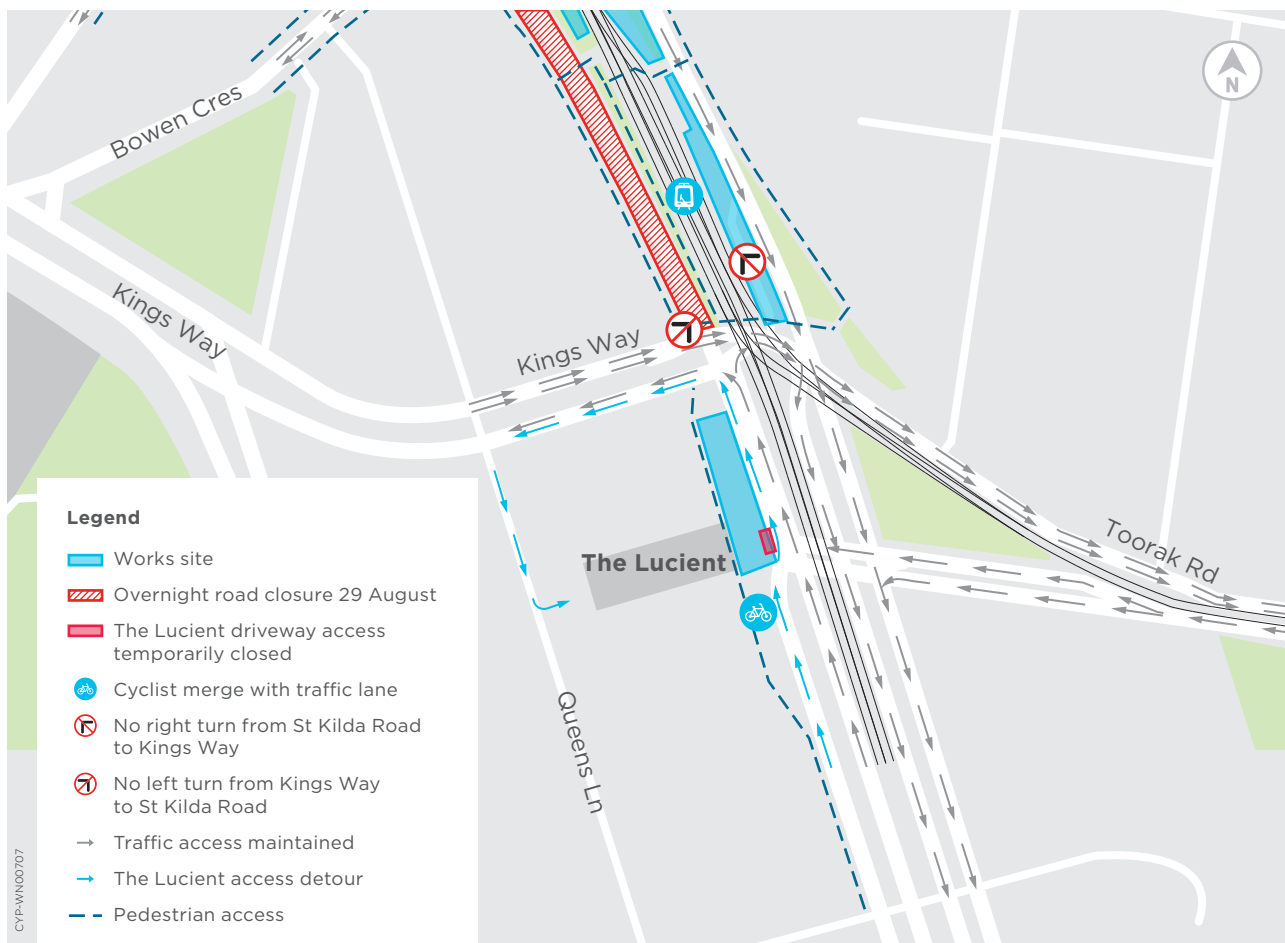
