

# **Works notice**

## **Overnight road resurfacing and utilities works** St Kilda Road and Toorak Road intersection and surrounds

### 6pm Sunday 26 November to 6am Saturday 2 December 2023

As part of the finishing works for the Metro Tunnel Project, the northbound lanes along the St Kilda Road and Toorak Road intersection and sections of the St Kilda Road southbound lane will be resurfaced. Some utility works will also be undertaken while these resurfacing works are underway.

To minimise disruption to traffic at this critical intersection and along St Kilda Road, works will take place overnight, 6pm to 6am, from 6pm Sunday 26 November to 6am Friday 1 December.

#### What we are doing

- While St Kilda Road is closed we are:
  - o Resurfacing the northbound lanes of the St Kilda Road and Toorak Road intersection road surface and the St Kilda Road surface between Arthur Street and Bowen Crescent
  - o Doing utility works along the northbound St Kilda Road lanes near Bowen Crescent
  - o Resurfacing the southbound St Kilda Road road surface between the Anzac Station tram stop and Toorak Road
- Closing the northbound and southbound lanes of St Kilda Road between Dorcas Street and Arthur Street each night, 8pm to 5am, from 8pm Wednesday 29 November until 5am Saturday 2 December
- Closing the northbound lanes along the St Kilda Road between Arthur Street and Park Street each night, 8pm to 5am, from 8pm Sunday 26 November until 5am Wednesday 29 November
- Road surfacing works on St Kilda Road involve removing the existing road surface and laying new asphalt by using a Non-Destructive Digging truck to expose underground conduits, profilers, pavers, compaction rollers, line marking machines and upgrading the traffic light system


- Utility works involve saw cutting, excavating, using a Non-Destructive Digging truck to expose underground conduits and hand tools
- Maintaining access to St Kilda Road driveways at all times
- Setting up work areas on St Kilda Road
- Reopening St Kilda Road each morning by 5am
- Working from 6pm to 6am, Sunday nights until Friday mornings.

#### What to be aware of

- Detours will be in place during the closure of the St Kilda Road and Toorak Road intersection:
  - o Detour to City for traffic along St Kilda Road via: Arthur Street, Queens Lane, Kings Way, Park Street and St Kilda Road
  - o Detour to City from South Yarra via: Punt Road and Alexandra Avenue
  - o Detour for traffic travelling away from City via: Dorcas Street, Kings Way, Queens Road, Lorne Street and St Kilda Road
- Pedestrian detours will be in place overnight at the Toorak Road intersection. Pedestrians can move through the area with the assistance of traffic controllers
- These works are expected to generate periods of high levels of noise associated with removal of the existing road surface and during saw cutting. Please also expect medium levels of noise while we excavate and do Non-Destructive Digging.

#### Utility installation on southbound lanes along St Kilda Road from 21 until 24 November 8pm to 5am each night


To complete utility works along St Kilda Road we're closing southbound lanes of St Kilda Road between Dorcas Street and Toorak Road overnight, 8pm to 5am each night, from 8pm Tuesday 21 November until 5am Friday 24 November.

#### Bowen Crescent closure from Tuesday 21 November until Saturday 25 November

As part of the finishing works for the Metro Tunnel Project we're closing Bowen Crescent at St Kilda Road to build a raised pedestrian crossing and install underground services, from Tuesday 21 November until Saturday 25 November. From Monday 27 November to 15 December, the left turn from St Kilda Road to Bowen Crescent will remain closed but access from Bowen Crescent will be open.
