Tower crane demobilisation and above ground structure works under road closure

Little La Trobe Street

From Wednesday 10 January 2024

As previously advised in the State Library Station December and January construction update, above ground structure works and the demobilisation of a tower crane will require a road closure of Little La Trobe Street, between Elizabeth and Swanston streets.



When we'll be working

- 24-hours, Monday to Sunday
- Mobile crane under road and footpath closure from 7am Wednesday 10 January until the work is complete
- Tower crane demobilisation from 13 January until the work is complete

The timing of work may change depending on weather.

What we'll be doing

- Closing Little La Trobe Street and a section of the southern footpath to facilitate the demobilisation of a tower crane from the La Trobe Street site and to use a mobile crane on Little La Trobe Street to construct the eastern above ground structure
- These works involve setting up a 250-tonne mobile crane on the road which will lift large pre-cast concrete panels from trucks onto the Little La Trobe Street site

- The crane will remain on the road even when it is not in operation
- Closing the southern footpath on Little La Trobe Street with no pedestrian access from Swanston Street except to the Scape building entrance on Little La Trobe Street (see map)
- Demobilising a tower crane from the La Trobe Street site
- These works involve the use of a mobile crane, trucks, hand tools, elevated works platforms, power tools and rattle guns
- Due to its size, the boom from the tower crane will extend across Little La Trobe Street under the existing road and footpath closure.

What to be aware of

- The works are expected to take up to two weeks to complete with the aim to reopen the road and footpath as soon as works are complete
- During this closure, motorist access to Little La Trobe Street and Literature Lane will be maintained via Elizabeth Street (see map)
- Local vehicle access to businesses and residential buildings will be maintained at all times under traffic control

- There will be no through access to Little La Trobe Street from Swanston Street for pedestrians, motorists, or cyclists
- Pedestrian access to Scape will be maintained from Swanston Street only
- Please allow additional travel time during these works
- Some of these works will generate high levels of noise. Please contact the project team if you have any concerns.

Where

- Little La Trobe Street, between Elizabeth and Swanston streets
- La Trobe and Little La Trobe Street sites.


