We're upgrading Bridge Inn Road between Plenty and Yan Yean roads to help you get home safer and sooner.

What's been happening

Since our last update, we've:

- moved all traffic onto the new westbound lanes of Bridge Inn Road between Resort Boulevard and Garden Road
- started upgrading the intersections at Cookes Road, Bassetts Road and Vantage Point Boulevard
- installed over two kilometres of new overhead powerlines.

New bridge over the Plenty River

In late December, we'll move traffic between the Plenty River bridge and Bassetts Road onto the new westbound lanes.

We'll keep one lane open in each direction while we upgrade the existing lanes. Refer to the map on the right for more information.

We'll also permanently change access to Towerhill Avenue to left in, left out only.

There's still some work left to do on the bridge before it's fully opened to traffic in 2024. The remaining works include assessing the structure of the existing bluestone bridge, and removing the existing pavement to convert the bluestone bridge to a shared walking and cycling path.

Did you know?

- The existing bluestone bridge over Plenty River is 155 years old.
- Over 2000m³ of concrete was poured to create the new bridge deck, which is enough concrete to fill an Olympic-sized swimming pool.

Bassetts Road reopening for summer

We're reopening Bassetts Road at Bridge Inn Road prior to Christmas.

The intersection will operate with temporary give way signage in place until the permanent traffic lights are switched on in March 2024, when Vantage Point Boulevard reopens.

We've still got some minor finishing works to complete in the new year. We'll close the intersection again in early 2024 for a few weeks to build the remaining kerbs and traffic islands.

What's happening in 2024

In 2024, we'll:

- complete Bassetts Road and Vantage Point Boulevard intersection upgrades
- upgrade Cookes Road intersection
- upgrade Painted Hills Road intersection
- install traffic lights at Garden Road
- finalise upgrades at Schotters Road and Mernda railway station
- convert the existing bluestone bridge over Plenty River to a shared walking and cycling path.

Our construction activities may generate varying levels of noise, dust and vibration at times. We'll have measures in place to ensure these impacts are minimised.

Most our works will take place between 7am and 6pm, Monday to Friday and 7am to 5pm, Saturdays. The progress of our works will depend on weather and ground conditions.

There will be intermittent lane closures on Bridge Inn Road over the next few months. When we need to work at night, we'll let you know ahead of time.
