







First Trains – 27 July 2023

Eastern Portal & Anzac Station















Trains at Line Speed – 80 Km per hour








Configuration for Ground-Borne Noise & Vibration Validation












Track Form Transition and vibration monitor install






Track form vibration monitoring performance






Upcoming validation testing and monitoring

Construction sites will be monitored by security during the closure. Members of the project will be on call during this time.



Lovers Walk and William Street bridge reopened



At the end of October 2023, we reopened Lovers Walk and William Street bridge as part of works to complete the surrounding infrastructure and roads.

You can now take William Street between Toorak Road and Arthur Street, or Lovers Walk




 Remaining works to complete the Osborne Street shared-use path (SUP) bridge started in November Works are expected to generate medium to high levels of noise with low to medium vibration.



Siding Reserve artwork construction update





- The remaining works include clearing redundant materials and re-landscaping the site area
- These activities will involve the use of a small crane to remove the temporary scaffold and crews with handheld tools to clear any redundant materials and re-landscaping the site area.
- Works are expected to generate low levels of noise.

Upcoming 24-hour rail maintenance works

Thursday 23 November to Monday 27 November



- Rail maintenance activities, including removing and relocating existing rail and signalling assets and upgrading signalling software along the rail corridor
- Testing and commissioning signalling assets
- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise with intermittent periods of high-level noise. Where possible, higher impact works will be scheduled to take place during the day and noise reduction mats will be placed around generators

- To support these works within the rail corridor, a section of Arthur Street will be closed overnight from Saturday 2 December to Sunday 3 December.
- Installing a fence within the rail corridor near the rail maintenance staircase
