

Works notice



Overnight Asphaltting

St Kilda Road

May 2024

In May, the final layers of asphaltting will be applied to St Kilda Road through the Metro Tunnel Project area.



When we'll be working

To minimise disruption to traffic on St Kilda Road, works will take place overnight, **8pm to 6am**.

- Southbound lanes:
8pm Tuesday 21 May to 6am Friday 24 May 2024
- Northbound lanes:
8pm Monday 27 May to 6am Friday 31 May 2024

The timing of work may change depending on weather.

What we'll be doing

- Closing the southbound lanes of St Kilda Road (away from city) between Linlithgow Avenue and the northern pedestrian crossing to Anzac Station tram stop overnight, to:
 - Lower a services pit lid in the southbound lane adjacent to Park Street
 - Asphalt the central section of St Kilda Road at Government House Drive
 - Asphalt the future left turn lane from St Kilda Road into Domain Road

- Installing final sections of kerb adjacent to the Domain Road station entrance
- Install signage.
- Closing the northbound lanes of St Kilda Road (towards city) between the Toorak Road tram stop pedestrian crossing and Bowen Lane overnight, to:
 - Remove traffic barriers adjacent to the roadway and remove temporary fencing adjacent to the tram tracks
 - Install final kerbing between St Kilda Road and the central median
 - Profile and asphalt the inner northbound lane between Toorak Road tram stop and Bowen Lane
 - Asphalt the separated bike lane adjacent to the Albert Road Reserve station entrance.
- Line mark the area.

What to be aware of

- Detours will be in place during the closure of St Kilda Road via Kings Way (See map)
- During works on northbound lanes, access for Albert Road properties will be via Kings Way. Egress to St Kilda Road will remain open

- During works on the northbound lanes, access for the St Kilda Road driveway of 400 St Kilda Road (Botanica) will be via Bowen Lane (See map)
- Access to properties will be maintained at all times, with traffic controllers in place to assist with changes to access
- Please expect periods of delays overnight when asphaltting is directly opposite the driveway
- Asphaltting works are expected to generate periods of medium levels of noise.

Where

- Southbound asphaltting works will be taking place between Southbank Boulevard and Anzac Avenue, and between Park Street and Domain Road
- Northbound asphaltting works will be taking place between Toorak Road tram stop and Bowen Lane, as well as a small section of asphaltting directly in front of the Albert Road Reserve station entrance
- Due to the nature of these works, progress may be impacted by weather conditions.

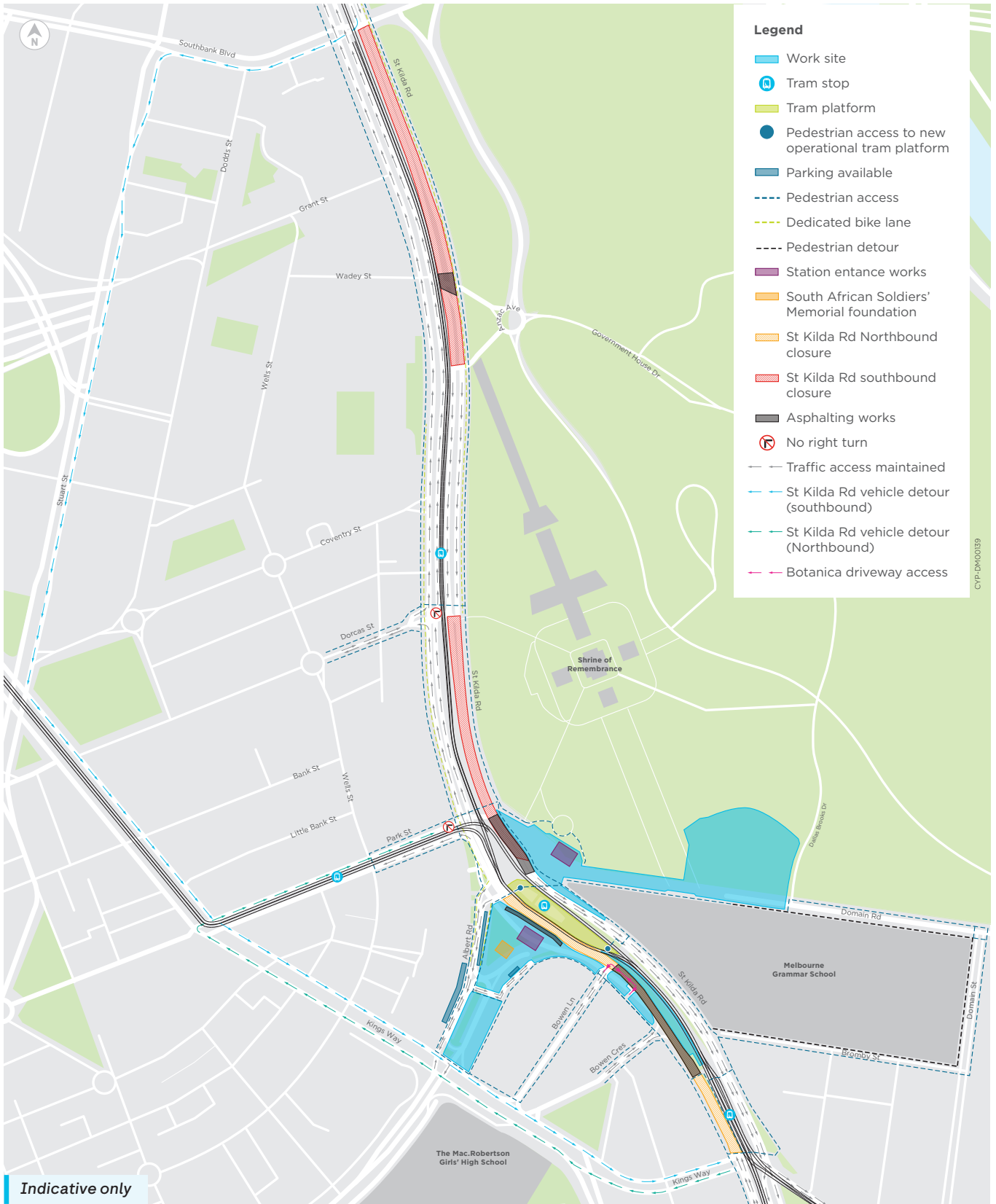
