

# Works notice



## Footpath closure

### Swanston Street

From mid-June to September 2024

As we progress with constructing a Town Hall Station entrance right next to Young and Jackson, a Swanston Street western footpath closure will be required outside the Flinders Quarter site from mid-June to September 2024.



#### When we'll be working

- From **mid-June to late September 2024**
- Work hours will be activity dependant with additional notification to be provided for specific night works.

The timing of work may change depending on weather.

#### What we'll be doing

- Removing the overhead site offices and gantries
- Constructing the above ground station entrance
- Kerb, repaving and landscaping works.

#### What to be aware of

- The Swanston Street western footpath at the Flinders Quarter site frontage will be closed between Young and Jackson and the Nicholas Building (refer to map). This area will be closed off using site fencing
- Pedestrians will detour to the Swanston Street eastern footpath, or via Degraves Street and Flinders Lane
- For one week, the northbound bicycle lane on Swanston Street will be closed between Flinders Street and Flinders Lane from midnight to 5am each night. Cyclists will need to dismount and follow the advice of traffic controllers to continue their journey

- These works will generate some periods of medium to high level noise and some vibration
- Access to businesses and residential properties will be maintained at all times.

#### Where

- Swanston Street outside the Flinders Quarter site entrance.

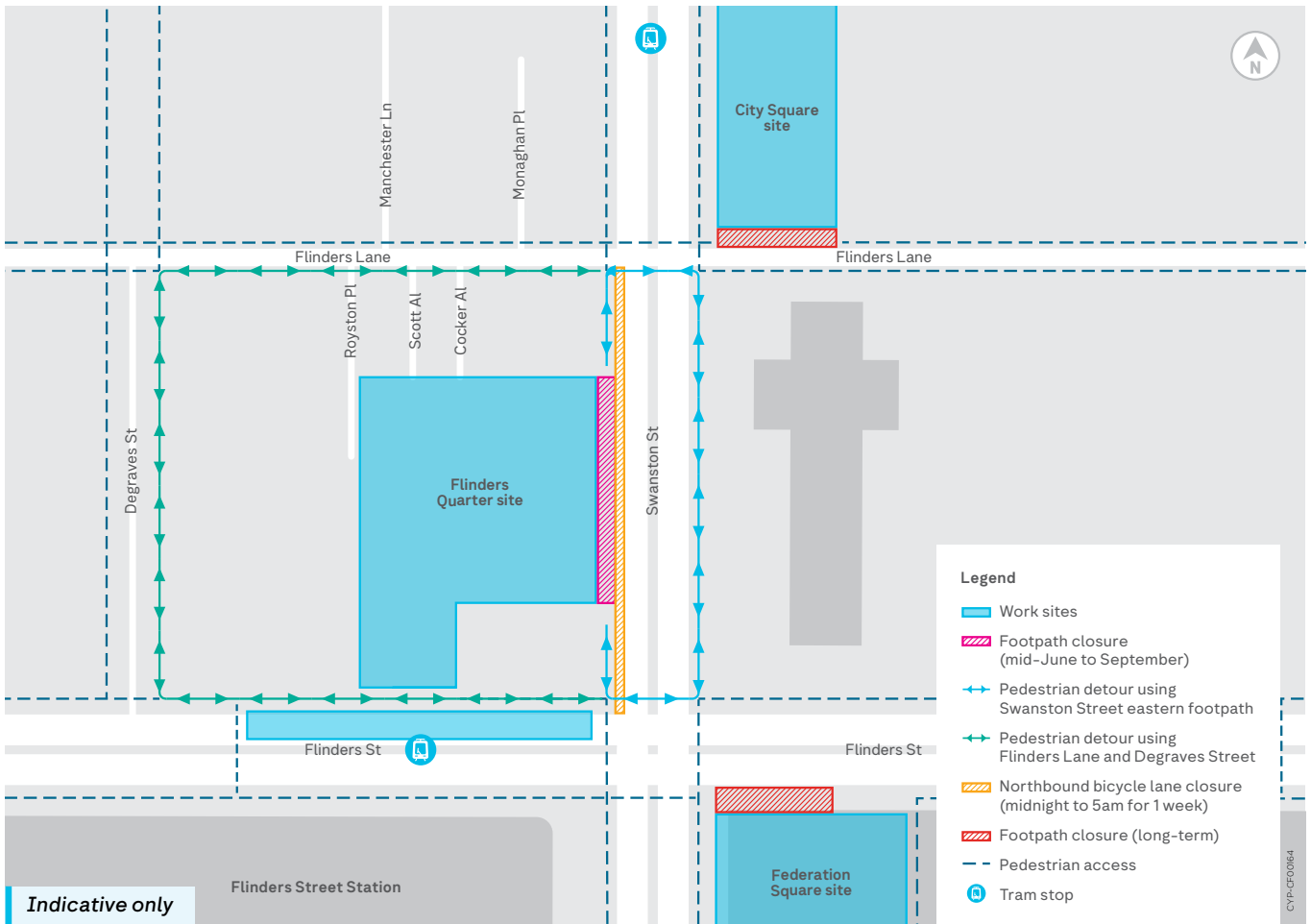
