Works are underway in Monash to deliver Suburban Rail Loop (SRL) East for Melbourne and Victoria.

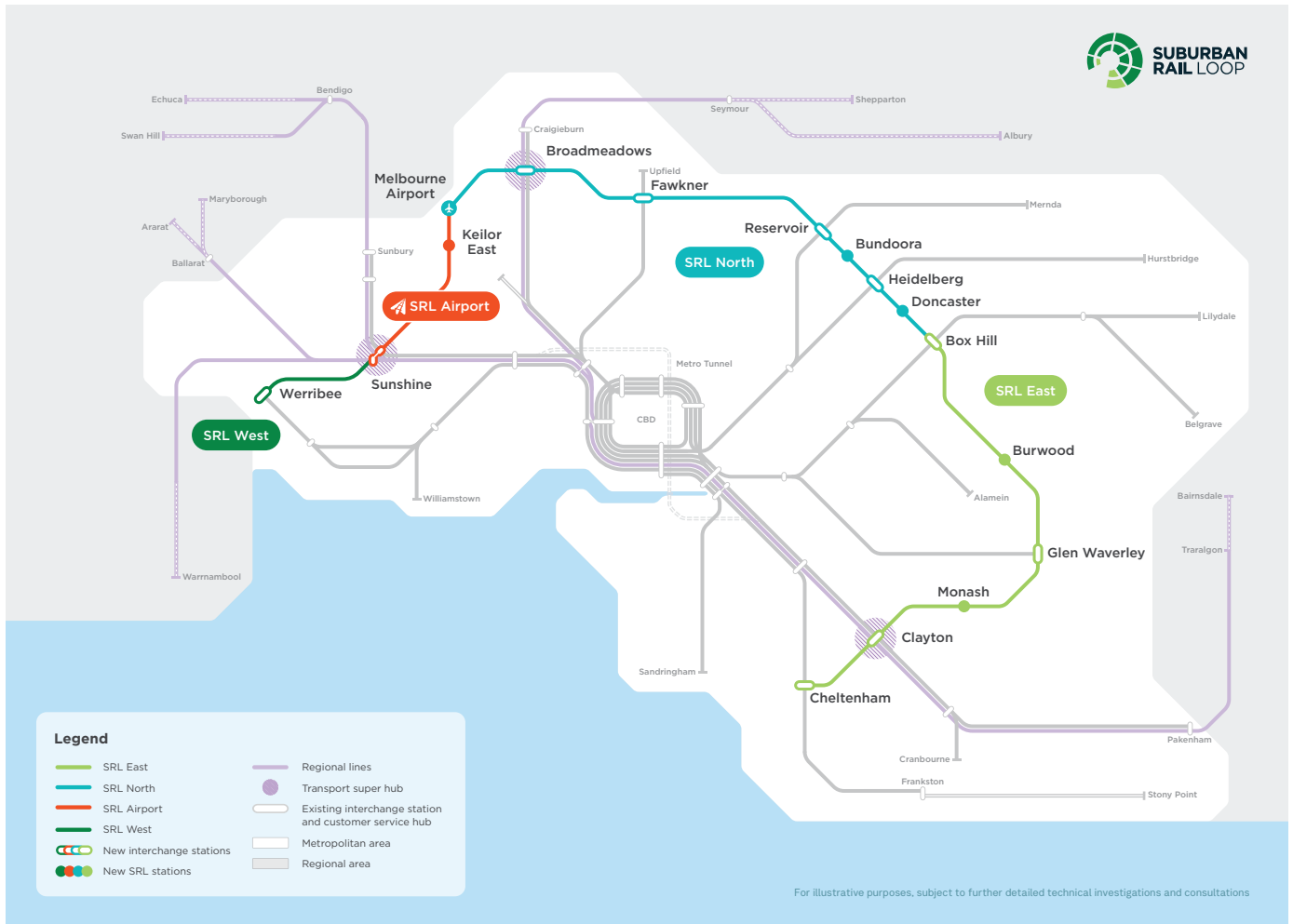

How we will manage our works

We will minimise impacts to the community by:

- Maintaining access to businesses during businesses hours, with help from traffic controllers where required
- Staging works along Howleys Road and Normanby Road to minimise traffic disruption
- Installing road safety and detour signage
- Notifying bus stop disruptions at the impacted stops ahead of time
- Transporting materials from site in covered trucks to minimise dust
- Positioning equipment as far as possible from businesses and residents and turning it off when not in use
- Safely removing hazardous materials in accordance with EPA regulations
- Monitoring noise, dust and vibration levels.
