

Heatherton and Clarinda works update

May 2025

Works are underway in Heatherton and Clarinda to deliver Suburban Rail Loop (SRL) East for Melbourne and Victoria.

What we are doing

Stabling Facility, Heatherton

- Building the Eastern Tunnel Entrance (ETE) and Western Tunnel Entrance (WTE)
- Building a permanent Network Support Facility (NSF)
- Moving underground and above ground services.
- Day works 7am 6pm Monday to Friday and 7am – 1pm Saturday

Tunnel Boring Machine (TBM) launch site, Clarinda

- Building the Clarinda Tunnel Access Structure (TAS)
- Connecting underground services.

Night works 6pm – 7am Monday to Sunday Extended works 6pm – 10pm Monday to Friday, 1pm – 5pm Saturday and Sunday, 24-hour works at times

Old Dandenong Road, Heatherton	Ongoing to late-June 2025	Moving underground services Road rectification and asphalting	 Overnight northbound closure between Kingston Road and Madden Road until late-May Southbound closure between Kingston Road and Madden Road from late-May, with crews working 24-hours Overnight road closure between Kingston Road and Madden Road for up to 10 nights, no access to Kingston Road Changed traffic conditions, with traffic management and detours in place until late-June Moderate levels of noise, vibration, light and dust
TBM launch site, Clarinda	Ongoing to late-2025	 Clarinda TBM launch site establishment, including earthworks, concreting, piling, hoarding installations and ground improvement Safely removing hazardous material 	 Workers in specialised protective clothing as we continue safe removal of hazardous materials Changed traffic conditions on Peace Road and Victory Road, with traffic management in place Moderate levels of noise, vibration, light and dust Increased truck movements

Impacts


As with all major infrastructure projects, surrounding communities may experience some impacts during construction. The Project supports businesses and residents to continue to live, work, study and shop in their community.
