Works are underway in Glen Waverley to deliver Suburban Rail Loop (SRL) East for Melbourne and Victoria.

- Oay works 7am 6pm Monday to Friday and 7am 1pm Saturday
- Night works 6pm 7am Monday to Sunday
- ▲ Extended works 1pm 5pm Saturday and 7am 1pm Sunday
- 24 hour works 7am 7am Monday to Sunday



How we will manage our works

We will minimise impacts to the community by:

- Maintaining access to the Waverley RSL and Montclair Avenue car parks
- Transporting materials from site in covered trucks to minimise dust
- Installing road safety and detour signage
- Maintaining access to homes and businesses
- Monitoring noise, dust and vibration levels

- Turning off equipment when not in use
- Using noise blankets on equipment
- Using water and dust suppressants
- Minimising light spill
- Coordinating disruptions with other construction companies in the area.
