

## Works Notification

### Substation works

Talmage Street, Albion

Ongoing to late 2021

As part of the Sunbury Line Upgrade, we are delivering power upgrades that will allow bigger, more modern trains to run on the Sunbury Line. We wish to advise of ongoing and upcoming works to build a new electrical substation on Talmage Street, Albion.

#### What we are doing

##### Trenching, services and pit installation works

- Using excavators and boring machines to dig underground and install communications and power services in excavated trenches
- Asphalt sawing and operation of non-destructive digging (NDD) trucks will facilitate the installation of underground services and pits. NDD uses pressurised water to break up and vacuum soil, exposing assets and services without damaging them.

##### Concrete pouring and substation foundation works

- Using excavators to dig underground and prepare the site for construction of the substation
- Using cement mixers to pour concrete and create the base slab for the substation foundations.

##### Drainage pipe installation works

- Using excavators to dig underground and install drainage pipes required for the new substation building.

#### When

- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 8am to 5pm Saturdays.

##### Trenching services and pit installation

- 15 May to late June 2021.

##### Concrete pouring and substation foundation works


- Mid-June - August 2021.

##### Drainage pipe installation works

- August to October 2021.

#### What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium to high levels of noise and low to medium levels of dust and vibration
- Some of the trenching works will be undertaken out of hours on Saturday between 1pm and 5pm. Construction activities that generate lower levels of noise will be undertaken during this time
- These works will allow further construction activities of the substation building in the coming months
- More details about future works will be provided closer to the date.



### New Albion substation urban design update

As detailed in this notification, major construction of the new substation is getting underway with construction expected to finish in late 2021.

The project team have finalised designs for the new Albion substation since the last round of artistic sketch impressions were released in late 2020. The colour and facade pattern of the substation have been updated to ensure the new building compliments the local area and the wider Albion precinct.
