Grants now open

Not-for-profit community organisations can apply for funding in three categories:

- Up to \$10,000 for a one-off project or activity that aims to improve community connectedness and participation
- Up to \$20,000 for festivals, events, and installations that bring local people together
- Up to \$100,000 for improvements to local community, sporting and recreation facilities, and local environments.



Footscray Wharf Promenade Project

Footscray Wharf and Promenade



Revitalisation of the Footscray Waterfront is underway.

What we are doing:
A \$12 million refurbishment of the river edge including a 230m long timber boardwalk with landings to the river, a wide promenade with avenue planting, seating, sheltered picnic spaces and lighting.

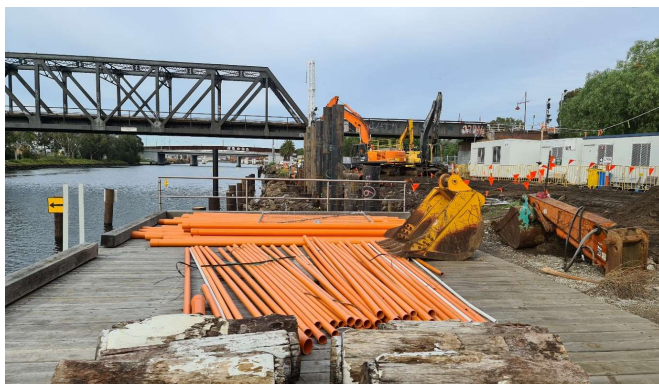
Works are expected to be completed in mid-2022.

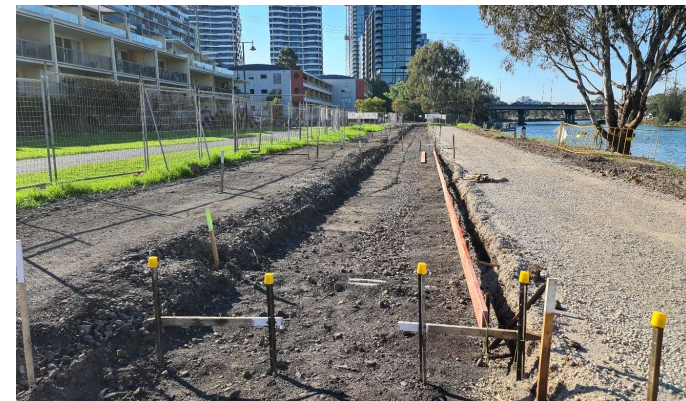

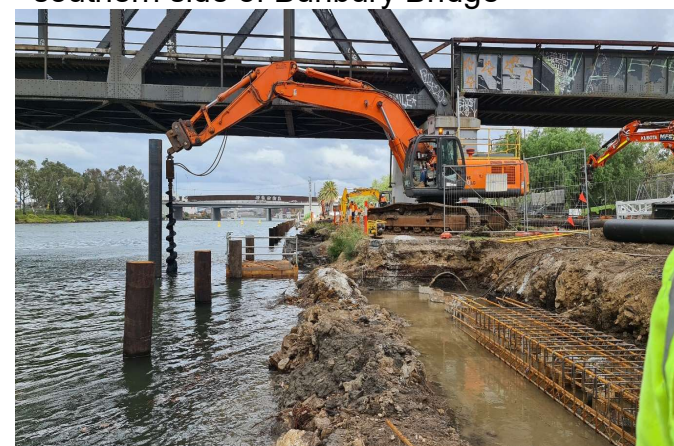
