

SYDNEY ROAD TO EDGARS ROAD



We've upgraded the M80 Ring Road between Sydney Road and Edgars Road.

We've added new lanes, upgraded key interchanges, built new on and off ramps and installed a smart freeway management system to provide safer and more reliable journeys for motorists in Melbourne's north.

Major works complete

We've reached a major milestone on the M80 Upgrade between Sydney Road and Edgars Road, with all major works now complete a year ahead of schedule and speed limits back to 100km/h.

The project has transformed one of Melbourne's busiest freeways, providing additional capacity and improving safety for more than 165,000 drivers each day.

We've installed a new smart freeway management system and ramp metering technology on this section of the M80. This innovative new system helps make travel times more reliable by controlling the flow of traffic on and entering the freeway. The system will also enable faster and more efficient response times to traffic incidents.

The new lanes and ramps were opened in stages between November 2021 and March 2022, allowing thousands of drivers to take advantage of the additional capacity, more than a year ahead of schedule.

While major works are complete, we'll continue to undertake landscaping works and some minor finishing works.

There may be some lane and ramp closures until the middle of the year to help us complete these works.

Thank you for your patience while we completed the upgrade.

Paving the way to sustainable outcomes

We've led the way in sustainability, becoming the first major road project in Victoria to include recycled content in every layer of road pavement. The equivalent of 35.5 million plastic bags were reused, which would otherwise have ended up in landfill, along with the equivalent of more than 22 million glass bottles, 800,000 toner cartridges and 820 passenger car tyres.


